While the winner does not receive direct exemptions to the following events, he will improve his chances of qualifying for the following events:

• 2026 FedEx St. Jude Championship	Top 70 FedExCup Points List through Wyndham Championship

MEDICAL EXTENSIONS

Players in the field on medical extensions

Players on a Major or Minor Medical Extension who meet their top 100 points will move to a category called Top 100 (Medical), listed just below exempt players on the Priority Ranking (note: if injured in a season prior to 2025, players can move to the Top 100 Medical category by reaching their top 125 number, as that was the threshold for eligibility in the season in which they were injured).

FIELD SIZE OF 147

Brooks Koepka is in the field at the Farmers Insurance Open, making his first start on the PGA TOUR (non-majors) since the 2022 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play. As part of the Returning Member Program, Koepka is added to the field (increased to 145), and two additional players are added (147) to ensure there are no twosomes or singles in the groupings as a result of Koepka being added to the field.

If there are any WDs before the competition starts (Koepka or any other player), that player will be replaced by the first alternate.
