Harris English snapped his 1,308-day winless drought at the 2025 Farmers Insurance Open capturing his fifth PGA TOUR career win in his 340th career start. English became the 32nd player to have multiple wins in the month of January in his PGA TOUR Career.

- 15** Birdies at the 2025 Farmers Insurance Open, tied 3rd for the fewest birdies by a winner at the Farmers Insurance Open Since 1983
- +6.04** Strokes Gained: Putting, English had the third highest total of any winner at the Farmers Insurance Open Since 2003
- 73** English finished his final round with a 73 (+1) becoming the third player to win the Farmers Insurance Open with a final round over par
- 5th** winner of the Farmers Insurance Open to start the final round with a bogey since 1983
- +2.09** Strokes Gained on the final 12 holes without making a birdie. English hit only 44% of fairways and 50% of greens in regulation in the final 12 holes but manage to not drop a stroke on any hole with six one putts gaining 1.38 strokes on the greens.

The Farmers Insurance Open, the third event of the 2026 PGA TOUR Season, is the third opportunity for players to earn FedExCup points towards the Aon Swing 5 with entry into each of the next two Signature Events (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational)

The top five players, not otherwise exempt, who earn the most FedExCup points during the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express, Farmers Insurance Open and the WM Phoenix Open will qualify for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational

The Aon Next 10 represents the top 10 players not already exempt, from the FedExCup standings, while the Aon Swing 5 includes the top five FedExCup points earners, not already exempt, from a collection of Full-Field Events leading up to each Signature Event. The Aon Next 10 for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational was determined through the 2025 FedExCup Fall standings
