Scottie Scheffler (1st/-17)

- World No. 1 earns his 21st PGA TOUR title in his 168th start at the age of 30 years, 1 month, 26 days
- Eight-stroke margin of victory is the largest by any player on TOUR since Scheffler won the 2025 CJ CUP Byron Nelson by eight
- Becomes the fifth player in the last 40 years to record multiple wins of 8+ strokes on TOUR, joining Tiger Woods (10), Ernie Els (2), Dustin Johnson (2) and Rory McIlroy (2)
- Scheffler's statistics this week:
 - Led the field in Strokes Gained: Putting with a career-best +8.92
 - Just the second event in his TOUR career as the leader in SG: Putting (2021 U.S. Open, +8.66)
 - Ranked second in SG: Approach the Green (6.643) and third in SG: Tee to Green (7.444)
 - Led all players with 23 total birdies (next best: 21, Tom Kim)
 - Six bogeys this week, tied for the second fewest bogeys-or-worse (best: 5, Maverick McNealy)
 - Win comes in his seventh appearance in the FedEx St. Jude Championship (previous best: T3 in 2025)
- Since the start of the 2024 season, leads all players with 15 PGA TOUR titles (next best: 6, Rory McIlroy)
- Led by two strokes entering the final round, his 15th time as the 54-hole solo leader; has won 12 of the 15 events where he was the solo leader entering the final round, including each of the last 11 occurrences; last time he did not win after holding the outright lead after three rounds was the 2022 TOUR Championship (finished T2)
- FedExCup standings notes:
 - Entered the week with a 794-point lead over No. 2 Matt Fitzpatrick in the FedExCup standings
 - With the win, earns 750 points and now holds a 1,447-point lead over Fitzpatrick
 - With the winner of next week's BMW Championship set to receive 750 points, Scheffler has secured the No. 1 position in the FedExCup standings ahead of the TOUR Championship (Aug. 27-30) regardless of the BMW Championship outcome
- 2026 season notes:
 - Earns his second win of the season and first since The American Express
 - Becomes the fifth player with multiple wins this season, joining Matt Fitzpatrick (3), Chris Gotterup (3), Cameron Young (2) and Wyndham Clark (2)
 - Fifth consecutive season with multiple PGA TOUR titles: 4 in 2021-22, 2 in 2022-23, 7 in 2024, 6 in 2025, 2 in 2026
 - 12 top-five finishes in 18 starts this season, including two wins and five runner-up finishes
 - In 18 starts this season, owns 17 made cuts, all of which resulting in top-25 finishes
 - Missed cut at the Genesis Scottish Open, his only MC since the start of the 2022 season (80 starts in that span)
- Becomes the 36th player to reach 21 career wins on the PGA TOUR; sits T32 on the all-time wins list in PGA TOUR history, joining Davis Love III, Willie MacFarlane, Lanny Wadkins, Craig Wood

FedExCup Playoffs:

- Following the conclusion of the FedEx St. Jude Championship, the top 50 players in the FedExCup standings qualify for next week's BMW Championship (Bellerive Country Club in St. Louis, Missouri) and also qualify for all 2027 Signature Events
- 31 of the top 50 players from the 2025 FedExCup standings are inside the top 50 again this year
- **Sungjae Im** is the only player to move inside the top 50 of the FedExCup standings after entering the week outside the bubble

Additional notes:

- **Si Woo Kim** (2nd/-9) finished runner-up for the third time this season (others: Farmers Insurance Open, CJ CUP Byron Nelson); earns his 11th top-10 finish on TOUR this year, second most by any player only behind Scheffler's 12; climbs to No. 4 in the FedExCup standings and is the only player inside the top five without a win this season
- **Alex Noren** (T3/-8) led the field this week in SG: Approach the Green (6.995) to notch his best finish of the season and moves from 46th to 34th in the FedExCup standings
- Playing in the final group with Scheffler, **Sam Burns** (T3/-8) cards a final-round 73; top-three finishes in three of his last four starts: 2nd/U.S. Open, T12/Travelers Championship, 3rd/The Open Championship, T3/FedEx St. Jude Championship
- **Justin Rose** (-6) finishes T39 in his attempt to defend his 2025 FedEx St. Jude Championship title
