Tom Kim (Winner/-17)

- Earns fourth PGA TOUR victory in 111th PGA TOUR start at the age of 24 years, 21 days
- PGA TOUR wins (4): 2022 Wyndham Championship, 2022 Shriners Children's Open, 2023 Shriners Children's Open, 2026 Genesis Scottish Open
- Joins Hideki Matsuyama (4) with the third-most PGA TOUR wins before the age of 25 by non-Americans on record (6/Rory McIlroy, 5/Sergio Garcia)
- Wins in his 67th start since his last victory at the 2023 Shriners Children's Open (a span of 1,001 days)
- Prior to win, had two top three finishes in 66 starts (2nd/2024 Travelers Championship, 3rd/2026 U.S. Open)
- Becomes the ninth international winner on TOUR this season (11th win)
- Joins Si Woo Kim (4) for the second-most wins on TOUR of a player from South Korea (most: 8/K.J. Choi)
- Becomes the first player from South Korea to win the Genesis Scottish Open
- Improves to 2-for-3 converting 36-hole lead/co-lead to victory on TOUR:
 - 2022 Wyndham Championship/Won
 - 2024 Travelers Championship/P2
 - 2026 Genesis Scottish Open/Won
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee To Green (12.220) and was the only player bogey-free for the final round
- Earns 500 FedExCup points and moves from No. 58 to No. 32 in the FedExCup standings
- Projected to move from No. 66 to No. 32 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- Win comes in fifth start and is one of two players to finish inside the top 25 at the event each year since 2022 (other: Wyndham Clark)
- Records third top-10 in 17 starts this season (T6/ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, 3rd/U.S. Open)

Additional notes

- Seeking his second PGA TOUR victory (2025 Texas Children's Houston Open), 54-hole co-leader **Min Woo Lee** (2nd/-15) earns fourth runner-up finish in his 84th start (2024 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches, 2024 Rocket Classic, 2026 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am)
- Other two third-round co-leaders finish T3 at 13-under 267: 2024 Genesis Scottish Open champion **Robert MacIntyre**, five-time PGA TOUR winner **Matt Fitzpatrick**
- 30-time PGA TOUR winner and 2023 Genesis Scottish Open winner **Rory McIlroy** (T7/-12) has finished T7 or better in all four starts at the event (Won/2023, T4/2024, T2/2025, T7/2026)
- Five-time PGA TOUR winner **Chris Gotterup** finishes T11 at 10-under 270 in his Genesis Scottish Open title defense
- The Genesis Scottish Open was the final event of The Open Qualifying Series (OQS) with three spots available into next week's 154th Open at Royal Birkdale Golf Club; the three nonexempt players who secured their spot to Royal Birkdale Golf Club: **Johnny Keefe** (T3/-13), **Michael Thorbjornsen** (T7/-12), **Victor Perez** (T9/-11)
