Second-Round Notes – Friday, July 10, 2026

Weather: Cloudy with morning showers. High of 85. Wind WSW 6-12 mph, gusting to 20 mph. Preferred lies were in effect for the second round.

Suspension/Delay summary: Due to heavy rain overnight (1.5 inches), the beginning of the second round was delayed one hour until 8 a.m. ET.

36-hole cut: 66 professionals and one amateur (Preston Stout) at 3-under 137 from a field of 141 professionals and three amateurs

Lucas Glover (1st/-13)

- Bogey-free through 36 holes for the second straight week (John Deere Classic), marking his first time to perform the feat in back-to-back stroke-play events (583 starts)
- Follows a first-round 63 with a 6-under 64, marking his ninth consecutive sub-70 round; opened 63-65 last week at the John Deere Classic en route to a T3 finish (his lone top-10 in 16 prior starts this season)
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (7.310), Scrambling (5/5), Sand Saves (T1; 2/2)
- Opened 63-68 and held the outright 36-hole lead in his only prior appearance at the event (2023/finished fifth)
- Holds 36-hole lead/co-lead for the 12th time; 1-for-11 to date (2023 FedEx St. Jude Championship); most recently held the solo-lead at last week's John Deere Classic (T3)
- 127 marks his career-best 36-hole score (previous best: 128/2026 John Deere Classic/T3)
- Held at least a share of the lead after five of his last six rounds (held 18-, 36- and 54-hole lead/co-lead last week)
- First time finishing inside the top five through 36 holes in back-to-back stroke-play starts since 2023 (T3/2023 Wyndham Championship/won, 1st/2023 FedEx St. Jude Championship/won)
- Tied with Max Homa for most PGA TOUR victories by any player in the field this week (6): 2023 FedEx St. Jude Championship, 2023 Wyndham Championship, 2021 John Deere Classic, 2011 Truist Championship, 2009 U.S. Open, 2005 FUNAI Classic at the WALT DISNEY WORLD Resort

Additional Player Notes

- First-round co-leader standings: **Lucas Glover** (1st/-13), **Steven Fisk** (T2/-11), **Stephan Jaeger** (T7/-8), **Troy Merritt** (T19/-6)
- **Chan Kim** (T2/-11) held the solo lead after 18 and 36 holes at this event last year, eventually finishing T14; finished T10 in his tournament debut in 2024
- **Steven Fisk** (T2/-11) is in search of his second victory in his 45th start (2025 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- **Aaron Wise** (T4/-10) is making his 129th start since his lone PGA TOUR win (2018 CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- **Jeong Weon Ko** (T4/-10) makes his first cut in seven PGA TOUR starts; 28-year-old Frenchman has played on the DP World Tour the past four seasons, with 55 made cuts in 109 starts and a career-best T2 at the FedEx Open de France (finished one stroke behind Michael Kim)
- **William Mouw** (6th/-9) and **Taylor Pendrith** (T9/-7) turned in the round of the day with matching 7-under 63s; Mouw trails by four in bid to become the first multiple winner of the ISCO Championship; Pendrith leads the field with three eagles
- Sitting on the cutline at the time, **Jackson Koivun** (T31/-5) birdies his final three holes for a 2-under 68 to make the cut for the first time as a professional; missed the cut in professional debut at the 2026 John Deere Classic
- Notable players:
 - **Preston Stout** (T31/-5) – 2026 NCAA individual champion
 - **Max Homa** (T47/-3) – six-time PGA TOUR winner

- **Cooper Musselman** (MC/-2) – Louisville, Kentucky native playing on sponsor exemption
 - **Adam Hadwin** (MC/+2) – former University of Louisville golfer (2005-09)
 - **Miles Russell** (MC/+2) – 17-year-old amateur standout
- **Jimmy Stanger** withdrew prior to the second round with an elbow injury
