Lucas Glover (1st/-15)

- Makes first bogey of the week at his 42nd hole
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for the seventh time; 2-for-6 to date (2023 Wyndham Championship, 2023 FedEx St. Jude Championship); most recently held the solo-lead at last week's John Deere Classic (T3)
- Sat T2 through 54 holes in his only prior appearance at the ISCO Championship (2023/finished fifth)
- 195 marks his second-best 54-hole score (192/2023 Wyndham Championship/Won)
- Held at least a share of the lead after six of his last seven rounds (held 18-, 36- and 54-hole lead/co-lead last week)
- Follows rounds of 63-64 with a third-round 68, marking his 10th consecutive sub-70 round
- Finished T3 at last week's John Deere Classic, his lone top-10 in 16 prior starts this season
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (11.160)
- Tied with Max Homa for most PGA TOUR victories by any player in the field this week (6): 2023 FedEx St. Jude Championship, 2023 Wyndham Championship, 2021 John Deere Classic, 2011 Truist Championship, 2009 U.S. Open, 2005 FUNAI Classic at the WALT DISNEY WORLD Resort

Additional Player Notes

- **Aaron Wise** (2nd/-14) is making his 129th start since his lone PGA TOUR win (2018 CJ CUP Byron Nelson); missed six consecutive cuts this season before posting a T39 at last week's John Deere Classic; played all three rounds 4-under or better this week, the fourth time where he has been 4-under or better in each round through 54 holes (most recent: 2022 CJ CUP Byron Nelson/finished T51 with final round 71)
- First-round co-leader **Stephan Jaeger** (T3/-13) seeks his second win in his 195th start (2024 Texas Children's Houston Open); improved his proximity to the hole in each round: R1 (33'11"), R2 (30'8"), R3 (25'3"); looks to become the fifth international winner of the ISCO Championship and first from Germany
- After a bogey at his first hole of the tournament, **Steven Fisk** (T3/-13) went 51 holes before a bogey at No. 17, the longest stretch without a bogey or worse of any player in the field; in search of his second victory in his 45th start (2025 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- Eight-time Japan Golf Tour winner **Chan Kim** (T3/-13) looks to become the sixth consecutive player to claim their first PGA TOUR title at this event; best finish this season: T26/Puerto Rico Open; T3 marks his best finish in 10 Korn Ferry Tour starts this season; making third appearance at this event (T14/ 2025, T10/2024)
- **Zac Blair** (T6/-12) cards his third 64 in 26 rounds at the ISCO Championship, equaling his low round at this event (R2 and R4/2024); had 13 one-putts, including 10 consecutive to begin the third round, his most to open a round in his PGA TOUR career (698th career stroke-play round)
- **Tom Hoge** (T6/-12) seeks his best finish in his fifth appearance at this event (T16/2015, T47/2016, T42/2017, T36/2019)
- **Ben Silverman** (T8/-11) was one of five players to card 64, the low round on Saturday (**Zac Blair, Kristoffer Ventura, Christo Lamprecht, Sam Bairstow**)
- Notable players:
 - **William Mouw** (T8/-11) – defending champion
 - **Jackson Koivun** (T18/-9) – made first cut as a professional this week
 - **Preston Stout** (T34/-7) – 2026 NCAA individual champion
 - **Max Homa** (T48/-5) – six-time PGA TOUR winner
