Playoff

- Steven Fisk defeated Taylor Pendrith with a par-4 on the third extra hole; both parred the first two holes
- Fifth playoff in ISCO Championship tournament history; first since Harry Hall defeated four players in 2024
- Seventh playoff this season; first since Viktor Hovland defeated Scottie Scheffler at the Travelers Championship
- Playoff format: 18 (repeated; the hole location was changed after the first two holes)
- Updated PGA TOUR playoff records: Steven Fisk (1-0), Taylor Pendrith (0-1)
- Aside from Scott Piercy's three-stroke victory in the inaugural event in 2015, the ISCO Championship has been decided by one stroke or a playoff in each of the 10 editions since

Steven Fisk (P1/-16)

- Picks up his second PGA TOUR victory in his 45th start at the age of 29 years, 2 months, 25 days
- PGA TOUR wins (2): 2025 Sanderson Farms Championship, 2026 ISCO Championship
- Was one of 12 players in the field who was also eligible for this week's Genesis Scottish Open at the time of the commitment deadline on Friday, July 3
- Snaps a streak of five straight first-time PGA TOUR winners at the ISCO Championship
- Collects 300 points and moves from No. 99 to No. 61 in the FedExCup standings
- Wins in his second appearance at the ISCO Championship (2025/T28, 2026/Won)
- Equals his best 72-hole score (264: 2025 Sanderson Farms Championship/Won)

Additional Player Notes

- 2024 CJ CUP Byron Nelson champion **Taylor Pendrith** (P2/-16) finishes runner-up for the second time in 130 starts (2022 Rocket Classic)
- **Ben Silverman** (T3/-15) equals career-best finish (2025 Bank of Utah Championship)
- **Aaron Wise** (T3/-15) earns his first top-10 since finishing solo-sixth at the 2022 CJ CUP in South Carolina
- **Lucas Glover** (T5/-14) falls to 2-for-7 when holding the 54-hole lead/co-lead; held at least a share of the 18-, 36- and 54-hole lead/co-lead the last two weeks (finished T3 at the John Deere Classic); final-round 1-over 71 snaps a streak of 10 consecutive sub-70 rounds on TOUR
- PGA TOUR Rookie **Davis Chatfield** (T5/-14) picks up his first top-10 finish in his 16th career start
- Notable players:
 - **William Mouw** (T10/-12) – defending champion
 - **Jackson Koivun** (T10/-12) – made first cut as a professional this week
 - **Max Homa** (T39/-7) – six-time PGA TOUR winner
 - **Preston Stout** (T49/-6) – 2026 NCAA individual champion
