Today – A slight chance for a shower exists this morning with mostly cloudy skies overhead. Skies should eventually become partly cloudy by midday with a limited threat for rainfall through the afternoon hours. The T-storm threat will begin to increase again this evening but most development likely holds off until after sunset. Southwest winds will be in place with a few gusts between 15-18 mph this afternoon. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.10" (2.5 mm). **Sunrise: 6:27am / Sunset: 9:07pm**

Extended forecast – Periods of scattered showers/T-storms intermixed with periods of dry weather are expected tonight, through the day Saturday. Any T-storm will be capable of producing heavy rainfall. The front associated with the active weather should eventually clear Louisville by Sunday with dry conditions returning. Wind gusts around 20 mph are possible on Friday, otherwise lighter winds are expected over the weekend.
