MEDICAL EXTENSIONS

Players in the field on medical extensions

Players on a Major or Minor Medical Extension who meet their top 100 points will move to a category called Top 100 (Medical), listed just below exempt players on the Priority Ranking (note: if injured in a season prior to 2025, players can move to the Top 100 Medical category by reaching their top 125 number, as that was the threshold for eligibility in the season in which they were injured; those players are noted by an asterisk *).

Jackson Koivun professional debut

Jackson Koivun, who earned his PGA TOUR card through PGA TOUR University Accelerated, is making his first start since turning professional and joining the PGA TOUR. Koivun secured his PGA TOUR card when he finished T4 at the 2025 NCAA Championship to earn the final point needed to reach the 20-point threshold in PGA TOUR University Accelerated. He was eligible to accept membership at the end of last season, or at the end of his junior or senior seasons, and he opted to return to Auburn for the 2025-26 season.
