Extended forecast– The Quad-Cities will be in a more active storm track Friday into the Saturday as waves of energy will produce thunderstorm complexes that will move across the state during the overnight into the morning hours each day. These complexes could be strong to severe with damaging wind, and heavy rainfall. Additional scattered thunderstorms may redevelop during the late afternoon and early evening hours with the heating of the day. The thunderstorm chances look to decrease on Sunday with slightly cooler temperatures in the mid-80s.
