Mark Hubbard (1st/-16)

- After failing to birdie a par-5 hole in the first 36 holes, birdies two of the three par-5s en route to a 7-under 64, one stroke shy of his career best on TOUR (63/six times)
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for the second time on TOUR (2022 Sanderson Farms Championship/finished T5)
- Seeks his first PGA TOUR win in his 274th PGA TOUR start, the second-most starts among active players on the PGA TOUR without a win on record (most: Patrick Rodgers/making 326th TOUR start at Truist Championship this week)
- Best finish on TOUR: T2/2019 Texas Children's Houston Open
- Best finish in 11 starts this season: T23/The Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches
- Played the front-nine holes 2-under for the week; back nine 14-under and bogey-free for the week
- Ranks No. 1 in both Stokes Gained: Tee To Green (8.574) and Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (8.815)
- Owns one victory on PGA TOUR Canada (2013 Wildfire Invitational) and one on the Korn Ferry Tour (2019 LECOM Suncoast Classic)

Miscellaneous Notes

- 36-hole leader **Aaron Rai** (2nd/-15), the highest-ranked player in the field at No. 42 in the Official World Golf Ranking, sits one stroke back in search of his second PGA TOUR victory (2024 Wyndham Championship)
- **Kevin Roy** (3rd/-14) cards a bogey-free 65, one of nine players with a bogey-free third round
- Paired together, **Mac Meissner** (T4/-13) and **Beau Hossler** (T4/-13) both shoot 7-under 64s while carding a combined 14 birdies, one eagle (Meissner/No. 13) and two bogeys (one each); both seek their first victory on TOUR (Hossler/243rd start, Meissner/67th start); Hossler owns four runner-up finishes (most recent: P2/2024 Sanderson Farms Championship) while Meissner has one runner-up result (2025 Wyndham Championship)
- 2026 Presidents Cup U.S. Team Captain, **Brandt Snedeker** (T4/-13) cards his seventh consecutive under-par round in individual stroke-play events on TOUR, dating to round one of the Valero Texas Open; his most recent of nine PGA TOUR victories came at the 2018 Wyndham Championship
- With a 7-under 64, **Brooks Koepka** (T7-11) posts his low round of the season on TOUR; back-nine 29 equals his low nine-hole score on TOUR (most recent: 2019 CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES/R4); improves his proximity to the hole with each round this week (35'7"/R1, 33'2"/R2, 25'4"/R3); largest come from behind to win at this event: 3 strokes/Ryan Fox 2025
- **Keita Nakajima** (T7/-11) cards a bogey-free 65 for the second time this week (65/R1)
- **Ryan Ruffels** (T43/-4), winner of The Q at Myrtle Beach and a sponsor exemption this week, cards a 1-over 72 to sit 12 strokes back
