Brandt Snedeker (Winner/-18)

- 2026 Presidents Cup U.S. Team Captain earns 10th PGA TOUR victory in his 471st start at 45 years, 5 months, 2 days
- Becomes 121st player in PGA TOUR history to reach 10 wins; moves to T109 on the all-time PGA TOUR wins list
- Wins in his 165th TOUR start since his last victory at the 2018 Wyndham Championship, a span of 7 years, 8 months, 21 days (2,821 days)
- **PGA TOUR wins (10):** 2007 Wyndham Championship, 2011 RBC Heritage, 2012 Farmers Insurance Open, 2012 TOUR Championship, 2013 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, 2013 RBC Canadian Open, 2015 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, 2016 Farmers Insurance Open, 2018 Wyndham Championship, 2026 ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic
- At 45 years-old, becomes the 13th different player 40 years or older to win on TOUR since 2020
- Joins Justin Rose and Gary Woodland as players in their 40s to win on TOUR this season
- Earns an exemption on the PGA TOUR through 2028 and qualifies for next week's PGA Championship, will be his 51st major championship start and first since the 2021 Open Championship (T19)
- Earns 300 FedExCup points and moves from No. 148 to No. 63 in the FedExCup standings
- Win comes in third start at the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic (MC/2024, MC/2025, Won/2026)
- Records first top-10 finish in eight starts this season (previous best: T18/Valspar Championship)

Mark Hubbard (2nd/-17)

- 54-hole leader earns second runner-up finish in his 274th start (T2/2019 Texas Children's Houston Open)
- Was seeking to become the third consecutive winner to record their first TOUR win at the event (Chris Gotterup/2024, Ryan Fox/2025)
- Records second top-10 finish at the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic in as many starts (T7/2025, 2nd/2026)
- With 274, holds the second-most starts among active players on TOUR without a win on record (most: Patrick Rodgers/326)

Miscellaneous Notes

- 18-year-old **Blades Brown** (T9/-13) earns second top-10 of the season (3rd/Puerto Rico Open) in his third start at the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic (T26/2024, T37/2025); following this week, needs 44 more FedExCup points to secure Special Temporary Membership
- Following a season-best 7-under 64, nine-time PGA TOUR winner **Brooks Koepka** (T11/-12) posts final-round 70
- The ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic is the first of three events where players can qualify for the next Signature Event, the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, via the Aon Swing 5; the five players (not exempt via the Aon Next 10 or a higher category) who earn the most FedExCup points in the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson and the Charles Schwab Challenge, will qualify for the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday
