**Extended forecast** – Shower chances are increasing for Saturday as a wave of low pressure tracks closer to the area, highest chances in the morning to early afternoon. A few thunderstorms are possible with this as well, with thunderstorm chances at 30-40%. Winds on Saturday will be light from the southeast in the morning turning more southwest in the afternoon. Sunday will trend drier with a mix of sun and clouds, though an isolated afternoon/evening shower/t-storm still cannot be ruled out. Winds Sunday will be light and variable in the morning turning light from the south-southwest in the afternoon.
