**Today** – Periods of rain and a few thunderstorms are expected at times today. The risk of thunderstorms is low in the morning, increasing some for the afternoon, highest chance between 12-6pm. Winds will be breezy from the southwest, with gusts to 25-30 mph, peaking 12-5pm, strongest near the ocean. Temperatures hold steady in the upper 60s to low 70s. **Rainfall today: 0.25-0.50", locally 0.75" with the heaviest storms.**

**Extended forecast** – Friday, expect mostly cloudy and slightly cooler conditions with lighter winds from the northeast in the morning, turning southeast for the afternoon behind a sea breeze. A chance showers returns on Saturday as a wave of low pressure tracks by the area. Thunderstorm chances are low with this, but cannot be ruled out. Sunday will see a chance of showers and a few thunderstorms, highest chance of thunderstorms in the afternoon and evening hours. The weekend forecast remains lower confidence and trends will be monitored.
