Ryan Fox the 2025 Champion is seeking his first successful title defense and the first at this event since Rory McIlroy in 2019 & '22 (*event not played in 2020 & '21*).

Brooks Koepka is currently 2nd in Greens in Regulation this season, on track for his highest rank in a season in his PGA TOUR Career (min 10 events played).

Nick Taylor became the first Canadian to win the RBC Canadian open in 69 years in 2023 (Pat Fletcher, 1954).

Wyndham Clark is making his 203rd PGA TOUR career start and has not finished outside the top 3 of an event in his last two starts

Sam Burns dominated the par 3's at the RBC Canadian Open finishing the week 6-under par, tied for his best Par 3 performance in his PGA TOUR career.

Kristoffer Reitan has earned 1,1359 FedExCup Points this season, the most of any rookie on the PGA TOUR this season with 965 of those points coming from his last 3 starts.

Alex Fitzpatrick Since the week of the Zurich Classic in New Orleans, Fitzpatrick has earned 1,117 FedExCup Points, the second most of any player since that event this season.

Robert MacIntyre missed the cut at the Memorial Tournament last week; he has two wins in a start after a missed cut with one being the RBC Canadian Open in 2024.

Shane Lowry has four top 15 finishes at the RBC Canadian Open, tied for his third most in an event in his PGA TOUR Career

Aaron Rai has played 100% of his rounds even par or better at the RBC Canadian Open, joining C.T. Pan as the only players to not have a round over par at this event since 1983 (Min 12 Rounds Played).

Justin Rose is making his 457th PGA TOUR career start and his 7th at the RBC Canadian Open (3 top 10's in previous 6 starts).

Collin Morikawa has spent 17 weeks inside the FedExCup top 10 this season, tied for the most weeks spent inside the FedExCup Top 10 in a season in his PGA TOUR Career.

Tommy Fleetwood has finished inside the top 25 in all three of his starts at this event, marking one of four events where he has never finished outside the top 25 (*min 3 starts*).

Sahith Theegala is one of 25 players to improve in SG Around-the-Green, Sand Save PCT and Scrambling from last season to this season.

Corey Connors is making his 11th start at this event, his best finish in his 10 previous starts is 6th (twice: 2022 & 2024), tied for his most starts in an event without a win.

Viktor Hovland has improved his putting from greater than 20 feet rank from 151st in 2025 to 14th this season moving 137 ranks, the fourth largest improvement of any player from last season to this season.

Matt Fitzpatrick is seeking to become the first English player to win 4 PGA TOUR events in a season and the first player to have 4 or more wins in a season since Scottie Scheffler in 2025.

Sudarshan Yellamaraju is one of four Canadians in the field 24 years or younger, with a win would be the first player 24 years or younger to win this event since 2000 (Tiger Woods – 24)

RBC Canadian Open

Ryan Fox earned his second PGA TOUR win in his 71st career start. He was the sixth multiple winner on TOUR in 2025. Earning 500 FedExCup points with his victory, Fox moved from 60th to 25th, the first time inside the top 25 of the FedExCup in his career.

- 62%** of his strokes gained for the week came from his stellar approach play, where Ryan Fox ranked Sixth in SG: Approach-the-Green and Second in SG: Tee-to-Green. For the week, Fox outperformed the field by 1.86 strokes per round on his approach play, his best SG: Approach-the-Green performance in a TOUR event.
- 5** one of 5 winners have made birdie or better the 18th hole all four rounds on TOUR since the start of the 2024 season
- 9** Ryan Fox is one of nine players to have multiple PGA TOUR career wins all won in a playoff since 2003

Ryan Fox led the field in Proximity to the Hole, averaging 25' 4" for the week, the third time in his TOUR career and second time this season leading an event in Proximity to the Hole. Fox averaged 18'7" to the hole in Round 1, his single best Proximity to hole average in a round out of 237 captured by ShotLink. On Sunday, his 25' 10" average was the eleventh time he averaged less than 26' in proximity to the hole in a single round on the PGA TOUR. He hit 81.9% of his greens in regulation, his best GIR percentage when making the cut on the PGA TOUR.

The last Signature Event in the 2026 PGA TOUR Season is the Travelers Championship, played the week after the U.S. Open. The top ten FedExCup points earners through the U.S. Open will earn spots in the Travelers Championship via the Aon Next 10. (As part of the Returning Member Program, should Brooks Koepka finish in the top 10 of the Aon Next 10 standings, the No. 11 player will also gain access to the next Signature Event).

The top five FedExCup points earners in the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson, Charles Schwab Challenge, and the RBC Canadian Open will earn spots in the Travelers Championship via the Aon Swing 5. (As part of the Returning Member Program, should Brooks Koepka finish in the top five of the Aon Swing 5 standings, the No. 6 player will also gain access into the next Signature Event).
