2026 RBC Canadian Open

Through 2028

If already exempt thru 2028, add one year to exemption (max thru 2031)

Exemptions to Majors and THE PLAYERS

- 2026 U.S. Open if second win in 500+ FedExCup point events since the 2025 U.S. Open
- 2027 PLAYERS Championship
- 2027 Masters Tournament
- 2027 PGA Championship

Exemptions to Signature Events

- 2026 Travelers Championship

While the winner does not receive direct exemptions to the following events, he will improve his chances of qualifying for the following events:

- 2026 U.S. Open
 - 2026 FedEx St. Jude Championship
 - 2026 BMW Championship
 - 2026 TOUR Championship
- Top 60 Official World Golf Ranking (June 15, 2026)
 - Top 70 FedExCup Points List through Wyndham Championship
 - Top 50 FedExCup Points List through FedEx St. Jude Championship
 - Top 30 FedExCup Points List through BMW Championship

MEDICAL EXTENSIONS

Players in the field on medical extensions

Players on a Major or Minor Medical Extension who meet their top 100 points will move to a category called Top 100 (Medical), listed just below exempt players on the Priority Ranking (note: if injured in a season prior to 2025, players can move to the Top 100 Medical category by reaching their top 125 number, as that was the threshold for eligibility in the season in which they were injured; those players are noted by an asterisk *).

Final medical starts

Charley Hoffman and Danny Willett are making the final start on their Major Medical Extension.

- » Charley Hoffman needs to win in order to reach his top 100 points. With a solo-2nd, he would move to the 101-110 medical category, and he would move to the 111-125 medical category with a tie for 2nd or solo-3rd. If he finishes worse than solo-3rd, he will move to the reorder category.
- » Danny Willett needs to finish in a 3-way tie for 2nd or better to reach his top 125 points. If he does not reach that number, he will move to the reorder category.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

Aon Swing 5

The Aon Swing 5 for the Travelers Championship is based on points from the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson, Charles Schwab Challenge and RBC Canadian Open, so this is the final opportunity to earn points towards that category.

U.S. Open qualification

The top 60 players in the Official World Golf Ranking on Monday, June 15 (through the RBC Canadian Open) will qualify for the U.S. Open.

The Open Qualifying Series

The leading three players, not already exempt, who make the cut at the RBC Canadian Open will earn a place in The 154th Open at Royal Birkdale.

With the exception of ties for first place, which would be decided by a playoff, ties for the qualifying place will be decided in favor of the highest ranked player in the Official World Golf Ranking at the beginning of the week (as of June 8).

If a successful qualifier later becomes exempt via another category, the place will **not** pass to the next non-exempt finisher.
