What are Shot Shapes?

Segmenting shots into left-to-right, straight, and right-to-left simplifies complex SHOTLink data into insights for fans, revealing player tendencies and strategy. It also enables clearer visualizations and comparisons that show how the world's best shape shots on demand to score.

Abbreviation	Definition
LTR	Left-To-Right Shape
RTL	Right-To-Left Shape
Straight	Any shot with less than a yard of curve

On the PGA TOUR last season, players favored a Left-to-Right (**55%**) shot shape off the tee compared to a Right-to-Left (**41%**) or Straight (**4%**) shot.

Last season, 5 of the 7 par 4s and par 5s on the back 9 at TPC Toronto favored a Left-to-Right shot shape off the tee. Overall at the RBC Canadian Open last season players favored a Left-to-Right (**60%**) shot shape off the tee compared to a Right-to-Left (**37%**) or Straight (**3%**) shot.

Curve Analysis

Last season players hit a Left-to-Right tee shot shape 60% of the time at the RBC Canadian Open with an average curve of 61 feet. The average curve when hitting the fairway was 51 feet compared to 79 feet when missing the fairway. Players favored a Right-to-Left tee shot shape 37% of the time with an average curve of 48 feet. The average curve when hitting the fairway was 40 feet compared to 62 feet when missing the fairway.

Right-to-Left Tee Shot Curve (ft) 2025 RBC Canadian Open Back 9

The 15th hole had the largest difference of Right-to-Left curve from players hitting the fairway vs missing the fairway at 33 feet. On the 15th hole 37% of tee shots favored a Right-to-Left shot shape with the average curve of players hitting the fairway was 39 feet compared to the average when missing the fairway of 72 feet. The largest curve to hit the fairway was 149 feet.

The 16th hole had the largest difference of Left-to-Right curve from players hitting the fairway vs missing the fairway at 44 feet. On the 16th hole 73% of tee shots favored a Left-to-Right shot shape with the average curve of players hitting the fairway was 45 feet compared to the average when missing the fairway of 89 feet. The largest curve to hit the fairway was 140 feet.
