MEDICAL EXTENSIONS

Players in the field on medical extensions

Players on a Major or Minor Medical Extension who meet their top 100 points will move to a category called Top 100 (Medical), listed just below exempt players on the Priority Ranking (note: if injured in a season prior to 2025, players can move to the Top 100 Medical category by reaching their top 125 number, as that was the threshold for eligibility in the season in which they were injured; those players are noted by an asterisk *).

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

Field size of 147

As part of the Returning Member Program, because Brooks Koepka was in the field as of noon on Monday, the field was expanded to 147 to round out groupings and the next two alternates (Lanto Griffin, Justin Lower) were added to the field. Although Koepka withdrew on Tuesday, the field remains 147 because the WD came after the expansion of the field. Koepka was replaced by Ben Silverman.

FedExCup Playoffs

There are two events remaining in the FedExCup Regular Season: Rocket Classic and Wyndham Championship.

The top 70 players in the FedExCup standings through the Wyndham Championship will qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs, which begin the following week at the FedEx St. Jude Championship. Players who qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs will secure their card for the 2027 season.
