Cameron Young (T1/-10)

- Ties the tournament course record with a second-round 9-under 61 (Jake Knapp/R2/2025, Peter Malnati/R1/2026)
- 61 marks the second-lowest 18-hole score of his PGA TOUR career (404 rounds), two strokes behind his career-low 59 at the 2024 Travelers Championship (R3/finished T9)
- Holds fourth 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR and second this season; 2-for-3 to date in converting to victory
 - 2023 John Deere Classic/finished T6
 - 2025 Wyndham Championship/Won
 - 2026 Cadillac Championship/Won
- Owns three made cuts and two top-10 finishes at the Rocket Classic (T2/2022, T6/2024, T46/2025)
- PGA TOUR wins (3): 2025 Wyndham Championship, 2026 PLAYERS Championship, 2026 Cadillac Championship
- One of four players with multiple wins on TOUR this season (Matt Fitzpatrick/3, Chris Gotterup/3, Wyndham Clark/2)
- World No. 3 now owns 21 consecutive made cuts on TOUR; last missed cut: 2025 Open Championship

Patrick Cantlay (T1/-10)

- Holds 10th career 36-hole lead/co-lead in individual stroke-play events on TOUR and first since the 2024 Genesis Invitational (finished T4); 1-for-9 to date (2021 TOUR Championship)
- Making his third appearance in the Rocket Classic where he owns one runner-up finish (T2/2022, T32/2025)
- Owns three top-10s in 16 starts this season (T7/Valspar Championship, T8/RBC Heritage, T10/Truist Championship)
- Currently sits No. 43 in the FedExCup standings; has finished 34th or better each of the last nine seasons
- Eight-time PGA TOUR winner seeks his first title since the 2022 BMW Championship

Patrick Fishburn (T1/-10)

- Holds 36-hole lead/co-lead for the third time on TOUR: 2024 RSM Classic (finished T8), 2025 Sony Open in Hawaii (T6)
- Career-best finish on TOUR in 73 starts is a pair of solo-third finishes (2024 Barracuda Championship, 2024 Procore Championship)
- Seeks to become the eighth first-time winner on TOUR this season and fourth in tournament history (Nate Lashley/2019, Cam Davis/2021, Aldrich Potgieter/2025)
- Making third start at the Rocket Classic (T25/2024, MC/2025)
- Enters the week at No. 145 in the FedExCup standings and owns two top-25 finishes in 16 starts this season, including a season-best T16 at last week's 3M Open

Additional notes

- With rounds of 67 and 64, **Matt Wallace** (T4/-9) records his best 36-hole score of the season (131); making his sixth start at the Rocket Classic (best: T10/2022)
- Rocket ambassador **Rickie Fowler** (T4/-9) records his best 36-hole score in eight appearances in the Rocket Classic with a 131, topping his previous best of 132 which came in his 2023 win at Detroit Golf Club

- First-round leader **Peter Malnati** (T6/-8) follows career-low 61 with a second-round 71; last top-10 finish on TOUR was his win at the 2024 Valspar Championship (61 starts since then)
- Making his Rocket Classic debut, 10-time PGA TOUR winner **Xander Schauffele** (T6/-8) sits two-shots back through 36-holes; seeks his first win since the 2025 Baycurrent Classic
- **Ryan Gerard** (T6/-8), No. 18 in the FedExCup standings, owns three runner-up finishes among five top-10s this season (2nd/the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, 2nd/Sony Open in Hawaii, T2/The American Express); leads the field this week in Strokes Gained: Putting (7.002)
- **Matt Kuchar** (T48/-4) records a hole-in-one on the par-3 No. 5, his seventh ace on TOUR, tying the most aces on TOUR since 2005 (others with 7: Robert Allenby, Scott Brown)
