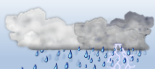
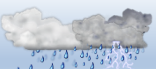
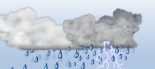

Today –Drier air will help keep showers to minimum this morning. There may be a passing sprinkle or very light shower through late morning. Otherwise, scattered showers will be more likely mid-day into the afternoon as the atmosphere moistens up. Cannot rule out an isolated thunderstorm developing as well. Rainfall amounts will average 0.10”-0.20” today with locally higher amounts if a thunderstorm passes overhead.

Sunday Forecast – A low-pressure system will be moving across Indiana/Ohio as we go through the day. This will provide bands of rain and embedded thunderstorms over Northern Ohio and SE Michigan during the morning into the early afternoon. Showers are forecast to taper-off during the mid to late afternoon as the system pulls away. Rainfall could be heavy at times with rainfall amounts a little as a 0.50” and as much as 1.50” depending on where the heavier rain bands set.
