What are Shot Shapes?

Segmenting shots into left-to-right, straight, and right-to-left simplifies complex SHOTLink data into insights for fans, revealing player tendencies and strategy. It also enables clearer visualizations and comparisons that show how the world's best shape shots on demand to score.

Abbreviation	Definition
LTR	Left-To-Right Shape
RTL	Right-To-Left Shape
Straight	Any shot with less than a yard of curve

On the PGA TOUR last season, players favored a Left-to-Right (**55%**) shot shape off the tee compared to a Right-to-Left (**41%**) or Straight (**4%**) shot.

Last season, 12 of the 13 par 4s and par 5s at Memorial Park favored a Left-to-Right shot shape off the tee. Overall at Texas Children's Houston Open last season players favored a Left-to-Right (**61%**) shot shape off the tee compared to a Right-to-Left (**35%**) or Straight (**4%**) shot. Memorial Park was tied for the highest Left-to-Right tee shot shape of any course last season.

Curve Analysis

Last season players hit a Left-to-Right tee shot shape 61% of the time at the Texas Children's Houston Open with an average curve of 58 feet. The average curve when hitting the fairway was 57 feet compared to 72 feet when missing the fairway. Players favored a Right-to-Left tee shot shape 35% of the time with an average curve of 46 feet. The average curve when hitting the fairway was 35 feet compared to 48 feet when missing the fairway.

Right-to-Left Tee Shot Curve (ft) 2025 Texas Children's Houston Open

The 18th hole had the largest difference of Right-to-Left curve from players hitting the fairway vs missing the fairway at 42 feet. On the 18th hole 55% of tee shots favored a Right-to-Left shot shape with the average curve of players hitting the fairway was 43 feet compared to the average when missing the fairway of 85 feet. The largest curve to hit the fairway was 148 feet.

Left-to-Right Tee Shot Curve (ft) 2025 Texas Children's Houston Open

The 14th hole had the largest difference of Left-to-Right curve from players hitting the fairway vs missing the fairway at 41 feet. On the 14th hole 64% of tee shots favored a Left-to-Right shot shape with the average curve of players hitting the fairway was 46 feet compared to the average when missing the fairway of 87 feet. The largest curve to hit the fairway was 170 feet.

Straight Shot Analysis

(A straight shot is defined as a shot that has less than a yard of curve)

At the Texas Children's Houston Open last season, Thomas Detry, Adam Svensson and Eric Cole hit the most straight tee shots with a driver at five drives for the week. Of the 13 total par 4s and par, the 14th hole had the most straight tee shots with driver in 2025 with 21 for the week.

Last season, two players hit over 50 straight tee shots with a driver with Sungjae Im hitting the most at 54 and Brian Harman second-most at 52. The Detroit Golf Club during the Rocket Classic had the most straight tee shots with driver in 2025 (238). In comparison, Memorial Park had 197 straight tee shots with driver at this event last year.
