While the winner does not receive direct exemptions to the following events, he will improve his chances of qualifying for the following events:

• 2026 FedEx St. Jude Championship	Top 70 FedExCup Points List through Wyndham Championship

MEDICAL EXTENSIONS

Players in the field on medical extensions

Players on a Major or Minor Medical Extension who meet their top 100 points will move to a category called Top 100 (Medical), listed just below exempt players on the Priority Ranking (note: if injured in a season prior to 2025, players can move to the Top 100 Medical category by reaching their top 125 number, because that was the threshold for eligibility in the season in which they were injured).
