**Today** – A low-pressure system will be dropping southward along the Southern California coast today. This will provide mostly cloudy skies across the area with mild temperatures in the low 70s. Showers will likely make it to the mountains during the late afternoon into the evening hours from this system. A very light shower or two could spill over into the Coachella Valley this evening, but most locations will remain dry.

**Extended forecast** – A low-pressure system will move across the Baja Friday into Saturday producing partly cloudy to mostly cloudy skies. Showers will be possible along the mountains to our west. Cannot rule out a few sprinkles or very light showers passing over the Coachella valley on Friday, but mainly dry conditions are expected. Otherwise, Partly cloudy to mostly sunny skies will return over the weekend with cooler temperatures by Sunday with highs in the upper 60s.
