**Wyndham Clark (1<sup>st</sup>/-30)**

- Wins his fourth PGA TOUR title in his 201<sup>st</sup> start at 32 years, 5 months, 15 days
- Final-round 60 (-11) sets new tournament record for the low final-round score (previous: 61/Xander Schauffele/2022); also shot 60 in what was the final round to win the 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro Am (weather reduced to 54 holes)
- One of four players to post 60 or better in the final round en route to victory on record: David Duval/1999 American Express (59), Stuart Appleby/2010 Greenbrier Classic (59), Tommy Gainey/2012 RSM Classic (60), Wyndham Clark/2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am (60)\* and 2026 CJ CUP Byron Nelson (60): Note \*54 holes due to weather
- Joins Si Woo Kim (R2/2026 CJ CUP Byron Nelson), Blades Brown (R2/Nicklaus Tournament Course) and Andrew Putnam (R2/La Quinta CC) – both at The American Express - with the lowest round on TOUR this season
- Back nine 28 (-7) ties low nine-hole score this season (Blades Brown/R2/Nicklaus Tournament Course/The American Express)
- 30-under 254 total marks his career low 72-hole total (previous: 263/2024 Travelers Championship) and one stroke shy of the tournament record (253/Scottie Scheffler/2025)
- Ranked No. 1 in Strokes Gained: Putting (12.573)
- Since last victory at the 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, had recorded two runner-up finishes (2024 Arnold Palmer Invitational, 2024 PLAYERS Championship)
- Last top-10 finish before this victory was T4 at the 2025 Open Championship
- Moves from No. 82 to No. 34 in the FedExCup
- Projected to move from No. 75 to No. 44 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- T13 at The American Express marked his best result in 12 prior starts this season
- Fourth start at THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson (MC/2019, T39/2021, MC/2022, Won/2026)
- PGA TOUR wins (4): 2023 Wells Fargo Championship, 2023 U.S. Open, 2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, 2026 CJ CUP Byron Nelson

**Miscellaneous Notes**

- **Si Woo Kim** (2<sup>nd</sup>/-27) captures second runner-up result this season (T2/Farmers Insurance Open); makes 33 birdies for the week, five more than the second-most 28 made by winner Wyndham Clark, and two birdies shy of the 35 made by Hideki Matsuyama at the 2025 Sentry, the most made in a 72-hole event on the PGA TOUR on record
- **Scottie Scheffler** (3<sup>rd</sup>/-25) makes one bogey for the week (No. 4/R3), the fewest of any player; World No. 1 has 32 straight top-25 finishes on TOUR; last finish outside the top 25: 2024 BMW Championship (T33)
- In his 40<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR start, **Jackson Suber** (4<sup>th</sup>/-23) posts his best finish and the fourth top-10 of his career (4<sup>th</sup>/2026 CJ CUP Byron Nelson, T6/2025 Sony Open in Hawaii, T6/2025 Rocket Classic, 7<sup>th</sup>/2025 Barracuda Championship)
- **Keith Mitchell** (5<sup>th</sup>/-22) records his best finish this season (previous: T6/Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches); posts his second top-10 in six starts at THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson where he has made the cut each time (T3/2018, 5<sup>th</sup>/2026);
- **Blades Brown** (T14/-18) earns 55 non-member FedExCup points to surpass the threshold to become eligible for Special Temporary Membership of the PGA TOUR

**Aon Swing 5 and Next 10**

- The Aon Swing 5 is made up of the five players, not otherwise exempt, who earned the most FedExCup points in the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson and the Charles Schwab Challenge to qualify for the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday:
