Extended forecast– The next wave of upper-level energy will produce another round of slow-moving showers and thunderstorms Thursday, especially during the afternoon and evening hours. Severe storms are not expected, but heavy rain and lightning will be likely. Thunderstorm chances are forecast to decrease Friday before an upper-level low-pressure system slowly moves across Texas. This will provided additional waves of slow-moving showers and thunderstorms across the region through the weekend into early next week.
