- 2027 PGA Championship

Aon Swing 5

The Aon Swing 5 for the Memorial Tournament is based on points from the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson and Charles Schwab Challenge.

The current Aon Swing 5 standings will carry over to the RBC Canadian Open, and after the U.S. Open, the Aon Next 10 and Aon Swing 5 for the Travelers Championship will be determined.

Player-hosted Signature Event

As one of three player-hosted Signature Events, the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday features two modifications:

- 36-hole cut to the low 50 players (and ties) and any additional players within 10 strokes of the 36-hole lead
- Three-year PGA TOUR exemption available to the winner

These two modifications are also in effect at The Genesis Invitational and Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard.

The Open Qualifying Series

The leading player, not already exempt, who makes the cut at the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday will earn a place in The 154th Open at Royal Birkdale.

With the exception of ties for first place, which would be decided by a playoff, ties for the qualifying place will be decided in favor of the highest ranked player in the Official World Golf Ranking at the beginning of the week (as of June 1).

If a successful qualifier later becomes exempt via another category, the place will **not** pass to the next non-exempt finisher.
