**COMPLETED Third-Round Notes – Sunday, June 7, 2026**

**Weather:** *Saturday:* Scattered thunderstorms and breezy. High of 84. Wind W 10-16 mph, gusting to 24 mph. *Sunday:* Partly cloudy. High of 85. Wind NW 4-8 mph.

**Suspension summary:** Due to dangerous weather in the area, round three was suspended at 11:16 a.m. ET and resumed at 12:59 p.m. (delay of 1 hour and 43 minutes). The third round was suspended again at 4:34 p.m. due to dangerous weather in the area and eventually suspended for the day at 5:55 p.m., with 32 players left to complete the round. The third round resumed Sunday at 7:31 a.m. and was completed at 10:30 a.m. The final round began as scheduled, featuring groups of three from 11:14 a.m. – 12:50 p.m. off Nos. 1 and 10.

**J.T. Poston (1<sup>st</sup>/-12)**

- Opened the third round at even par thru five holes with a birdie on No. 2 and bogey on No. 4 before play was suspended due to weather; played his last 13 holes in 3-under for a 69 to take the solo lead by four strokes
- Marks the first time he has played consecutive rounds in the 60s at Muirfield Village in 27 career rounds (65-69)
- Secures his fifth 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; 2-for-4 to date in converting to victory (2022 John Deere Classic, 2024 Shriners Children’s Open)
- Seeks to become the eighth player and first since Cameron Young (Cadillac Championship) to successfully convert the 54-hole lead/co-lead this season
- One top-25 result in seven prior appearances at the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday (T22/2024)
- Two top-25s in 13 starts this season (T21/Valero Texas Open, T24/Truist Championship)
- Seeks his fourth career PGA TOUR victory in his 257<sup>th</sup> start (2019 Wyndham Championship, 2022 John Deere Classic, 2024 Shriners Children’s Open)
- Entered the week at No. 114 in the FedExCup and projected to move to No. 32 with a win
- Celebrated his 33<sup>rd</sup> birthday on Monday of tournament week (June 1)

**Additional Player Notes**

- First-round co-leader **Ryan Gerard** (2<sup>nd</sup>/-8) sits four shots back in search of his second TOUR title in 70<sup>th</sup> start (2025 Barracuda Championship); three top-10 finishes in 2026 includes two runner-up finishes (2<sup>nd</sup>/Sony Open in Hawaii, T2/The American Express)
- Five-time PGA TOUR winner **Sam Burns** (3<sup>rd</sup>/-7) seeks his first title since the 2023 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play; two best finishes this season have come in a Signature Event (T6/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am) and a major championship (T7/Masters Tournament)
- Making his first start since his victory at THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson, **Wyndham Clark** (T4/-6) seeks to become first player since Matt Fitzpatrick (2026 RBC Heritage, 2026 Zurich Classic of New Orleans) to win in back-to-back starts on TOUR
- **Tommy Fleetwood** (T4/-6) seeks his first top-3 finish since winning the 2025 FedExCup; owns five top-10s in 10 starts this season
- Two-time defending champion and World No. 1 **Scottie Scheffler** (T10/-3) trails by nine in bid to become the first player to win an event on TOUR in three consecutive years since Steve Stricker (2009-2011 John Deere Classic)
- **Alex Noren** (T7/-4) cards the low round of the day with a 5-under 67
- **Maverick McNealy** (T7/-4) is the only player in the field to go bogey-free in the third round (68); owns one-top 10 in 13 starts this season (10<sup>th</sup>/Farmers Insurance Open)
