Wyndham Clark (T1/-5)

- 67 marks his low score in 19 career rounds at the Muirfield Village Golf Club (previous: 68/R1/2022)
- Seventh career 18-hole lead/co-lead in individual stroke-play events on TOUR (most recent: 2025 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard/finished T22); 0-for-6 converting to victory
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (6.067) and Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (4.621) in round one; marks his best career performance in a round in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (previous: 3.626/2025 3M Open/R2)
- One top-15 finish in six career tournament appearances (T12/2023)
- In his first start since winning THE CJ CUP Bryon Nelson, seeks to become the second player this season to win in back-to-back starts (Matt Fitzpatrick/RBC Heritage, Zurich Classic of New Orleans)

J.J. Spaun (T1/-5)

- 67 marks his low score in 11 career rounds at Muirfield Village Golf Club (previous: 70/R3/2023)
- Ninth career 18-hole lead/co-lead in individual stroke-play events on TOUR (most recent: 2026 Charles Schwab Challenge/finished T6); 1-for-8 converting to victory (2025 U.S. Open)
- Joins co-leader Ryan Gerard as first players to hold the 18-hole lead/co-lead in back-to-back weeks on TOUR since Keith Mitchell (2025 Valspar Championship, 2025 Texas Children’s Houston Open)
- Two top-10 finishes in his last three starts on TOUR (T6/Charles Schwab Challenge, T5/Truist Championship)

Tommy Fleetwood (T1/-5)

- Opens with bogey-free 67, his low score in 13 career rounds at Muirfield Village (previous: 69/R1/2024)
- Was 11-of-11 in Scrambling, the most saves in a round at Muirfield Village when finishing with a 100% Scrambling percentage (previous: 9/7 times)
- In his 175th PGA TOUR start, holds his fifth career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (most recent: 2023 Open Championship/finished T10); 0-for-4 converting to victory
- Five top-10s in 10 starts this season (best: T4/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am); entered the week No. 15 in the FedExCup

Ryan Gerard (T1/-5)

- 67 included eight birdies, the most in the field in round one
- Third career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (most recent: 2026 Charles Schwab Challenge/finished T10) 0-for-2 converting to victory
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (3.701) in round one
- Joins co-leader J.J. Spaun as first players to hold the 18-hole lead/co-lead in back-to-back weeks on TOUR since Keith Mitchell (2025 Valspar Championship, 2025 Texas Children’s Houston Open)
- Three top-10 finishes in 2026 includes two runner-up finishes (2nd/Sony Open in Hawaii, T2/The American Express)

Additional Player Notes

- Two-time defending champion and World No. 1 **Scottie Scheffler** (T33/+1) opens with a 73, his third over-par score in an opening round on TOUR this season (73/WM Phoenix Open/finished T3; 74/The Genesis Invitational/finished T12); looks to become the first

player to win an event on TOUR in three consecutive years since Steve Stricker (2009-2011 John Deere Classic); has seven top-10 finishes in 11 starts this season, including one win at The American Express

- **Nick Taylor** (5th/-4) seeks to become the first Canadian to win the Memorial Tournament; best finish in six prior starts in this event is solo fourth (2025)
- 2010 Memorial Tournament winner **Justin Rose** (T6/-3) opens with 69 in his 17th tournament appearance; marks his fourth opening-round score of 69 or better at Muirfield Village (68/2008, 65/2010, 68/2015)
