J.T. Poston (1st/-9)

- With a 7-under 65, cards the low round of the day and his lowest 18-hole score in 26 rounds at Muirfield Village; previous: 68/R2/2022; equals his low round of the season (R3/American Express)
- Next best round of the day: 69 (Ryan Gerard, Sam Burns, Eric Cole, Jacob Bridgeman, Matt McCarty)
- Holds 36-hole lead/co-lead for the fifth time on TOUR; 2-for-4 to date in converting to victory (2022 John Deere Classic, 2024 Shriners Children’s Open)
- Ranks No. 1 in Strokes Gained: Approach The Green (7.902) after hitting 27 of 36 greens in regulation; also ranks No. 1 in Strokes Gained: Tee To Green (8.880) and No. 1 in Proximity (25 feet, 2 inches)
- Two bogeys through 36 holes marks the fewest by any player in the field
- One top-25 result in seven prior appearances at the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday (T22/2024)
- Two top-25s in 13 starts this season (T21/Valero Texas Open, T24/Truist Championship)
- PGA TOUR victories (3): 2019 Wyndham Championship, 2022 John Deere Classic, 2024 Shriners Children’s Open
- Celebrated his 33rd birthday on Monday of tournament week (June 1)

Additional Player Notes

- First-round co-leader **Ryan Gerard** (2nd/-8) cards 13 birdies through 36 holes, the most of any player in the field; finished T23 in his lone start at this event (2025)
- Five-time PGA TOUR winner **Sam Burns** (3rd/-6) seeks his first title since the 2023 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play; two best finishes this season have come in a Signature Event (T6/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am) and a major championship (T7/Masters Tournament)
- **Tommy Fleetwood** (4th/-4) seeks his first top-3 finish since winning the 2025 FedExCup; owns five top-10s in 10 starts this season
- **Eric Cole** (5th/-3), who was defeated by Russell Henley in a playoff at last week’s Charles Schwab Challenge, is one of 13 players in the field seeking their first PGA TOUR victory; seven players have made the Memorial Tournament their first PGA TOUR title (most recent: William McGirt/2016)
- After missing the cut in his first appearance at this event (2018), World No. 10 **Xander Schauffele** (T6/-2) has posted seven consecutive top-25 results at the Memorial Tournament
- Four major champions sit inside the top 10 on the leaderboard: **Xander Schauffele, Wyndham Clark, Aaron Rai, Shane Lowry**
- Two-time defending champion and World No. 1 **Scottie Scheffler** (T19/+1) plays his last six holes in 3-under; finished outside the top-25 twice in his last 52 starts on TOUR (T33/2024 BMW Championship, T41/2024 U.S. Open); looks to become the first player to win an event on TOUR in three consecutive years since Steve Stricker (2009-2011 John Deere Classic)
