Today – High clouds will filter the sunshine this morning, but skies will become mostly sunny this afternoon with max temperatures around 26C. Winds will be light out of the east through the mid-morning but will gradually move around to the northwest by early afternoon and increase with gusts around 21mph.

Tonight – High clouds will return this evening with temperatures falling into the mid teens. Winds will begin to diminish after 1900 hours with wind gusts dropping below 15mph by 2200 hours.

Friday through Monday – Expect mainly cloudy skies through the morning on Friday but skies will become mostly sunny in the afternoon with winds increasing. Wind gusts will reach 22mph. Max temperatures will remain in the mid 20s. Saturday a weak trough dropping down from the north will allow for showers to develop along the Pennines in the afternoon. A shower or two may make it into Southport late in the afternoon and into the evening. Otherwise expect partial sunshine, cooler temperatures and the afternoon sea breeze developing. Sunday will be partly sunny with the afternoon sea breeze continuing. High pressure moves in from the west on Monday allowing for winds to stay out of the northwest throughout the day with partial sunshine and max temperatures around 20C.
