Min Woo Lee (1st/-8)

- 62 ties his career-low 18-hole score on TOUR (2026 American Express/R1/Nicklaus Tournament Course)
- Third career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR and third this season (The American Express/finished T38, PGA Championship/finished T18)
- One of six players making their TOUR Championship debut; would be the first player since Xander Schauffele (2017) to win the TOUR Championship in their tournament debut
- Entered the week at No. 21 in the FedExCup with four top-10s in 19 starts this season, including two runner-up finishes (T2/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, 2nd/Genesis Scottish Open)
- Seeks second career PGA TOUR victory in his 88th career start (2025 Texas Children's Houston Open)

Miscellaneous player notes

- 2023 FedExCup Champion **Viktor Hovland** (T2/-6) holed 141 feet, 3 inches worth of putts, his third-most in a round on TOUR; making his seventh consecutive TOUR Championship appearance, with 64 his low opening-round score (previous: 66/2021)
- Coming off a T4 at last week's BMW Championship, **Collin Morikawa** (T2/-6) posts 64 and leads the field in Stroke Gained: Putting (3.384) after round one; making his seventh consecutive TOUR Championship appearance after collecting one win (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am) and six other top-10 finishes this season
- **Chris Gotterup** (T2/-6) posts bogey-free 64 to begin his second TOUR Championship appearance (T10/2025); three-time winner this season finished T4 at last week's BMW Championship to enter the week at No. 6 in the FedExCup
- 2024 FedExCup Champion **Scottie Scheffler** (T5/-5) cards bogey-free 65, his third consecutive opening-round score of 65 or better at the TOUR Championship (65/2024, 63/2025)
- Reigning FedExCup Champion **Tommy Fleetwood** (T9/-4) seeks to become first back-to-back FedExCup Champion; is the only player in the field this week to finish inside the top-10 in the first two FedExCup Playoffs events
- **J.J. Spaun** WD during the first round with a shoulder injury
