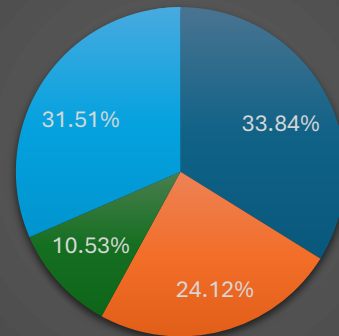

Top 30 Broadcast Notes

Scottie Scheffler (1st) enters the TOUR Championship ranked 1st for the 5th time in his TOUR career, the most of any player in the FedExCup all-time. Scheffler enters the week ranked 1st in the FedExCup for the 80th week in his TOUR career, the second most of any player in the FedExCup all-time. Scheffler has a Scoring Average (Actual) of 67.96 in 2026, the lowest Scoring Average (Actual) in a season on the PGA TOUR since 1983.
