**Scottie Scheffler** has hit 78.54% of greens in regulation at this event, marking the highest percentage of any player at TPC River Highlands all-time (min 12 rds played).

**Sam Burns** in his last 8 PGA TOUR starts this season has 2 Top 5 finishes and has finished 43.75% of his rounds inside the Top 10 compared to 22.3% in his first 7.

**Tommy Fleetwood** has played 100% of his opening rounds in the 60s at the Travelers Championship, marking one of two events in his career where he has accomplished this (min 4 rounds played).

**Wyndham Clark** is seeking to become the 6<sup>th</sup> player All-Time and the first since Ernie Els at the 1997 FedEx St. Jude Championship to win the week after Winning the U.S. Open

**Keegan Bradley** the 2-time Travelers Champion is seeking to become the third player All-Time to earn 3 or more wins at this event (Billy Casper, 4 & Bubba Watson, 3)

**Jordan Spieth** has played in 196 total events since his win at the 2017 Travelers Championship, earning 3 wins in that time span including his win at the 2017 Open Championship

**Matt Fitzpatrick** ranks inside the top 2 in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green, Around-the-Green & Tee-to-Green this season, the only player to rank inside the top 2 in multiple Strokes Gained categories this season.

**Justin Thomas** has finished inside the Top-10 in each of his last three starts at this event, tied for his longest consecutive Top-10 finish streak.

**Russell Henley** has a scoring average of 67.63 at the Travelers Championship his lowest at a Signature Event since 2024

**Cameron Young** recorded a 59 at the 2024 Travelers Championship in Rd 3, one of two sub 60 rounds at the Travelers Championship (58, 2016 Jim Furyk Final Rd)

**Collin Morikawa** in his 5 previous starts at this event Morikawa has never finished inside the Top 10 at the Travelers Championship, his second most starts without a Top 10 at an event in his PGA TOUR career (Best Finish: T13, 2024)

**Xander Schauffele** has ranked inside the Top 5 in SG: Putting 3 times at the Travelers Championship tied for the most of any player in the ShotLink Era (Keegan Bradley & Heath Slocum)

### Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Keegan Bradley earned his 8<sup>th</sup> PGA TOUR career win in his 368<sup>th</sup> start. Bradley becomes the 8<sup>th</sup> player to win the Travelers Championship multiple times (2023 & 2025).

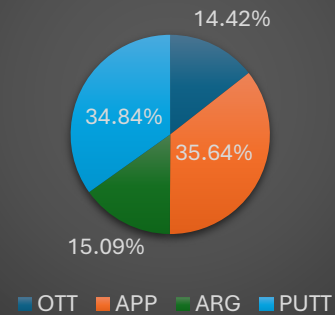

**Sam Burns** is coming off a runner-up finish at the 2026 U.S. Open, his best finish in a major in his PGA TOUR career. Burns in his last 8 PGA TOUR starts this season has 2 Top 5 finishes and has finished 43.75% of his rounds inside the Top 10 compared to 22.3% in his first 7. Burns has earned 1,613 FedExCup points this season, the third most of any player without a win. In the last 3 PGA TOUR seasons Burns has the Highest PCT of Putts Made > 10', making them 18.48% of the time (*min 75 rds*).

Fleetwood finished T2 at the 2025 Travelers Championship, his best finish in an event following a runner-up in the start prior was T14 at the 2018 WGC-Workday Championship.

**Keegan Bradley**, two-time winner of the Travelers Championship and defending champion is set to make his 16<sup>th</sup> start at this event. It was 728 days between Bradley's wins at this event, the third shortest span of days between wins at this event. Bradley has 16 consecutive rounds of par or better entering this week, the longest active streak of any player at this event since 2022. Bradley has never successfully defended a title in his PGA TOUR Career with his best finish being T2 in 2013.
