Ben James sponsor exemption

Ben James, who earned his PGA TOUR card by finishing No. 1 in the PGA TOUR University Ranking and made his first start as a member at the RBC Canadian Open, received one of the four sponsor exemptions, which are restricted to PGA TOUR members.

James and Jackson Suber are making their first start in a Signature Event this season, bringing the total number of unique players to compete in Signature Events this season to 113 (2025: 112).

This is the fourth consecutive year that a player who recently joined the TOUR through PGA TOUR University has received a sponsor exemption to the Travelers Championship (Ludvig Åberg in 2023, Michael Thorbjornsen in 2024, Luke Clanton in 2025).

The Open Championship qualification

The first five PGA TOUR members and any PGA TOUR members tying for fifth place, not otherwise exempt, in the top 20 of the FedExCup Points List through the Travelers Championship will qualify for The Open Championship.
