**Alex Fitzpatrick (1<sup>st</sup>/-14)**

- Earns his first 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR in his 13<sup>th</sup> career start
- 64 marks his best 18-hole score on TOUR (previous: 66 in the second round of last week’s Cadillac Championship)
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (9.843) and Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (7.571)
- Making the third start of his rookie season: Won/Zurich Classic of New Orleans, T9/Cadillac Championship
- Earned his first PGA TOUR victory two weeks ago at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with brother and World No. 3 Matt Fitzpatrick) in his 11th start on TOUR
- With the win, earned PGA TOUR membership through the 2028 season, along with exemptions into the remaining 2026 Signature Events, 2026 PGA Championship and 2027 PLAYERS Championship
- Looks to join his brother Matt Fitzpatrick, as well as Chris Gotterup and Cameron Young, as the only players with multiple wins on TOUR this season
- Prior to winning the Zurich Classic of New Orleans, owned two professional victories at the 2026 Hero Indian Open (DP World Tour) and 2023 British Challenge (HotelPlanner Tour)

**Kristoffer Reitan (2<sup>nd</sup>/-13)**

- PGA TOUR rookie seeks his first title in his 15<sup>th</sup> career start
- Bogey-free 64 marks his lowest round on TOUR (previous: 65, 2025 Genesis Scottish Open/R2)
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (5.989)
- Best finish in 11 starts this season is T2 at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with teammate Kris Ventura) while his best finish in individual stroke play is T10 at the Valero Texas Open
- Earned a spot in the field through the Aon Swing 5 standings (No. 5)
- Two-time winner on the DP World Tour, with both wins coming last year; earned PGA TOUR membership for the first time by finishing inside the top 10 of the DP World Tour’s 2025 Race to Dubai
- No. 54 in the FedExCup standings, owns four top-25 finishes, including two top-10s, in 11 starts this season

**Cameron Young (3<sup>rd</sup>/-12)**

- Won last week’s Cadillac Championship with a six-stroke margin of victory, his second win of the season and third of his career (2025 Wyndham Championship, 2026 PLAYERS Championship)
- Seeks to become the second player this season to win back-to-back events (Matt Fitzpatrick, RBC Heritage and Zurich Classic of New Orleans)
- In his last five starts on TOUR, owns two wins and two T3 finishes: T3/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, Won/THE PLAYERS Championship, T3/Masters Tournament, T25/RBC Heritage, Won/Cadillac Championship
- Ranks No. 3 in both the Official World Golf Rankings and 2026 FedExCup standings

**Additional notes**

- Green Monster (Nos. 16-18) statistics through three rounds: the field is -291 on Nos. 1-15 and +146 on Nos. 16-18
- In 22 years of the Truist Championship, the winner led or co-led after 54 holes nine times: Sepp Straka (2025), Wyndham Clark (2023), Max Homa (2019), Jason Day (2018), Rory McIlroy (2015), J.B Holmes (2014), Anthony Kim (2008), Jim Furyk (2006), David Toms (2003)
- The last four events on TOUR were won by players who held the 54-hole lead/co-lead: Rory McIlroy (Masters Tournament), Matt Fitzpatrick (RBC Heritage), Alex and Matt Fitzpatrick (Zurich Classic of New Orleans), Cameron Young (Cadillac Championship)

- The largest 54-hole deficit overcome to win this season is four strokes (Cameron Young/THE PLAYERS Championship and Chris Gotterup/WM Phoenix Open)
- 36-hole leader **Sungjae Im** (T4/-10) cards a third-round 70 as he seeks his third PGA TOUR win and first since the 2021 Shriners Children's Open
- 16-time PGA TOUR winner **Justin Thomas** (T6/-9) seeks his second career victory at Quail Hollow Club (2017 PGA Championship) and first win on TOUR since the 2025 RBC Heritage
- **Nico Echavarria** (T25/-3) aces the par-3 17th at Quail Hollow Club, the third hole-in-one of his career (2023 RSM Classic/R3/No. 6, 2025 Genesis Scottish Open/R4/No. 6) and the fifth hole-in-one at No. 17 in tournament history (Colt Knost/2015/R2, Carlos Ortiz/2016/R3, Mark Hubbard/2023/R2, Chandler Blanchet/2026/R2)
- Additional notable players in the field:
  - 2011 Truist Championship winner **Lucas Glover** (T17/-5), making his 22<sup>nd</sup> career appearance in the event
  - Defending champion **Sepp Straka** (T37/-1)
  - Four-time Truist Championship winner **Rory McIlroy** (T37/-1) ranks first in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (3.805) and 69<sup>th</sup> of 72 players in Strokes Gained: Around the Green (-4.203)
