**Kristoffer Reitan (1<sup>st</sup>/-15)**

- After entering the day one stroke behind 54-hole leader Alex Fitzpatrick, cards a final-round 2-under 69 for a two-stroke victory over Rickie Fowler and Nicolai Højgaard; picks up his first PGA TOUR victory in his 15<sup>th</sup> start at the age of 28 years, 2 months, 2 days
- PGA TOUR rookie moves from No. 54 to No. 13 in the FedExCup standings
- Fourth first-time winner this season, joining Jacob Bridgeman/The Genesis Invitational, Ricky Castillo/Puerto Rico Open and Alex Fitzpatrick/Zurich Classic of New Orleans
- Becomes the seventh player to earn first TOUR victory at the Truist Championship, joining Wyndham Clark/2023, Max Homa/2019, Derek Ernst/2013, Rickie Fowler/2012, Rory McIlroy/2010 and Anthony Kim/2008
- Second player from Norway to win on the PGA TOUR, joining seven-time winner Viktor Hovland
- Fifth international player to win the Truist Championship, joining Jason Day (Australia), Rory McIlroy (North Ireland), Vijay Singh (Fiji) and Sepp Straka (Austria)
- Week included a third-round, bogey-free 64, his lowest round on TOUR (previous: 65, 2025 Genesis Scottish Open/R2)
- Best finish in 11 prior starts this season is T2 at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with teammate Kris Ventura); previous-best finish in an individual stroke play is T10 at the Valero Texas Open
- Earned a spot in the field through the Aon Swing 5 standings (No. 5)
- Two-time winner on the DP World Tour, with both wins coming last year; earned PGA TOUR membership for the first time by finishing inside the top 10 of the DP World Tour's 2025 Race to Dubai

**Additional notes**

- **Rickie Fowler** is the only player with top-10 finishes in each of the last four Signature Events (T9/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, T8/RBC Heritage, T9/Cadillac Championship, T2/Truist Championship); the six-time TOUR winner (including his first win at the 2012 Truist Championship) now has 16 runner-up finishes in 377 starts
- In search of his first PGA TOUR victory in his 67<sup>th</sup> start, **Nicolai Højgaard** finishes runner-up for the second time this season (Texas Children's Houston Open) and the fifth time overall
- 54-hole leader **Alex Fitzpatrick** cards a final-round 2-over 73 to finish solo-fourth and three behind Reitan; marks his third straight top-10 finish (Zurich Classic of New Orleans/1<sup>st</sup>, Cadillac Championship/T9, Truist Championship/4<sup>th</sup>)
- Four-time Truist Championship winner **Rory McIlroy** (T19) ranked first in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (4.192) and 65<sup>th</sup> out of 72 players in Strokes Gained: Around the Green (-3.475); now has 13 top-20 finishes in 15 starts at the event
- **Matt Fitzpatrick** finishes T52 in bid for his third straight win (RBC Heritage, Zurich Classic of New Orleans)
- Defending champion **Sepp Straka** finishes T63; no player has successfully defended at the Truist Championship
- Cumulative Green Mile (Nos. 16-18) statistics: the field was -396 on Nos. 1-15 and +214 on Nos. 16-18
