Matt Fitzpatrick is seeking to become the first player since Dustin Johnson in 2017 to have 3 consecutive starts with a win on the PGA TOUR

Rory McIlroy has 4 PGA TOUR wins at Quail Hollow Club, is seeking to become the first player since Tiger Woods at Augusta National Golf Club to win at the same course 5 or more times.

Tommy Fleetwood ranks 4th in Strokes Gained: Around-the-Green this season, his best rank in this category in his PGA TOUR career and first season inside the top 5 since 2022.

Si Woo Kim is coming off back to back top 4 finishes, his second time this season to finish inside the top 4 in back to back starts (Farmers Insurance Open / T2 & WM Phoenix Open / T3)

Rickie Fowler is coming off back to back top 10 finishes in Signature Events and his first time finishing inside the top 10 in back to back starts since the playoffs last season at the FedEx St. Jude Championship (T6) and BMW Championship (T7)

Alex Fitzpatrick is making his 13th PGA TOUR start following a win and top 10 in his last two starts. This Week the Fitzpatrick brothers will be teeing it up as opponents, and Alex's best finish in a stroke play event with Matt in it was T17 at the 2023 Open Championship.
