Extended forecast– Upper-level energy may produce a passing shower Saturday, but the higher likelihood will be to the south and east of Charlotte. Otherwise, partly cloudy skies and warmer temperatures can be expected with highs in the mid to upper 70s. Partly cloudy skies and warmer temperatures will continue Sunday before the next system approaches Sunday night into Monday. Showers and isolated thunderstorms will become likely on Monday as the cold front moves across the state.
