COURSE EVACUATION PLAN

In the event of severe weather or any other emergency condition that requires a suspension of play and/or evacuation of the golf course, the following procedures will be in effect from Monday, June 15^h until the conclusion of the U.S. Open Championship.

Suspension of Play – Dangerous Situation: will be signaled by **one-prolonged** blast of an air horn. When this occurs, player groups must stop play immediately and proceed directly to their assigned evacuation site as dictated by the group’s location on a particular hole or practice area

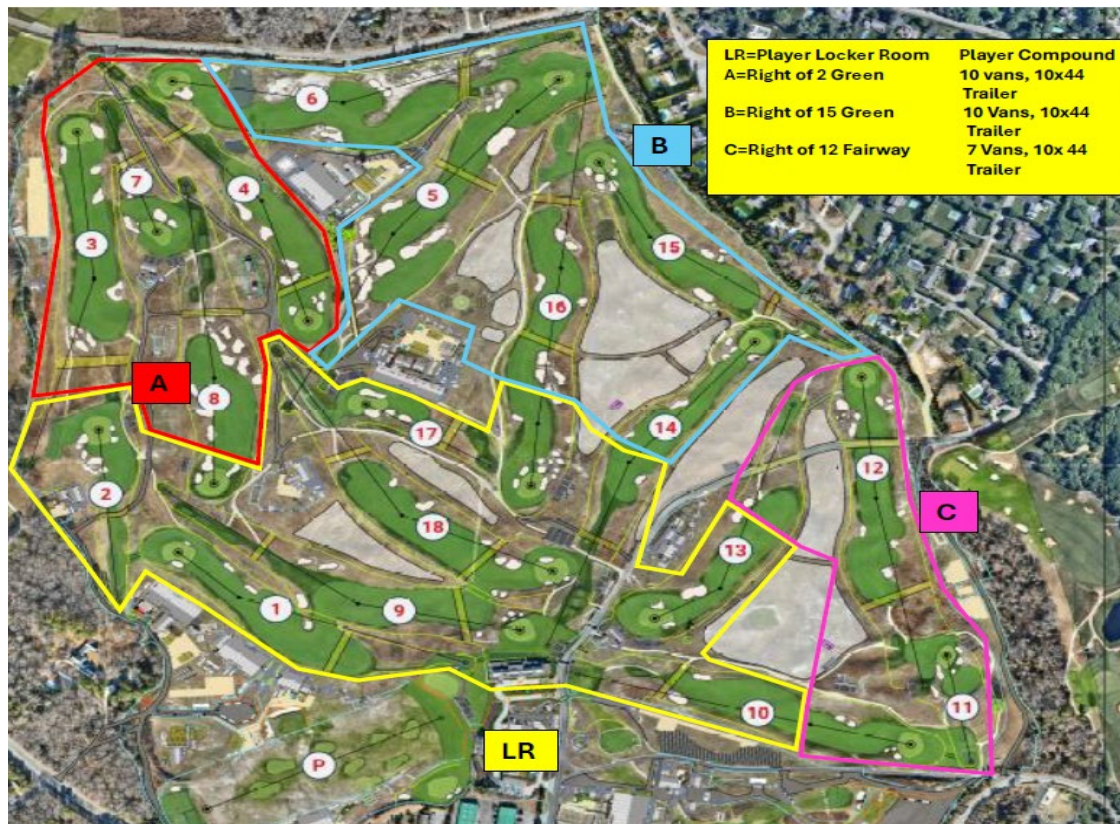
Suspension of Play – Non-Dangerous Situation: will be signaled by **three short** blasts of an air horn. When this occurs, player groups can choose to finish playing their current hole before proceeding to their assigned evacuation.

WHERE TO PROCEED DURING EMERGENCY EVACUATION

Player groups will proceed to their assigned evacuation site based on their position on the golf course. The following chart shows each golf course position and the corresponding evacuation site.
