**J.J. Spaun (1<sup>st</sup>/-17)**

- 2025 U.S. Open champion picks up his third PGA TOUR victory in his 252<sup>nd</sup> start at the age of 35 years, 7 months, 15 days
- PGA TOUR wins: 2022 Valero Texas Open, 2025 U.S. Open, 2026 Valero Texas Open
- Becomes the 11<sup>th</sup> multiple winner of the Valero Texas Open and the first since Corey Connors (2019, 2023)
- Edges Matt Wallace, Michael Kim and Robert MacIntyre by one stroke, becoming the eighth out the last 10 TOUR events to be decided by one stroke or in a playoff (others: Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches/2 strokes, Texas Children’s Houston Open/5 strokes)
- Entered the final round two strokes behind MacIntyre; closed with a 5-under 67 for a one-stroke victory
- Moves from No. 115 to No. 24 in the FedExCup standings
- Projected to move from No. 13 to No. 6 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (9.280)
- Wins in his eighth start at the Valero Texas Open, with two top-10 finishes (wins: 2022, 2026)
- Victory is his first top-10 finish of the season (previous best finish: T24/THE PLAYERS Championship)

**Additional notes**

- **Matt Wallace** (T2/-16) picks up his second top-3 finish in four starts at the Valero Texas Open (3<sup>rd</sup>/2021, T2/2026); 2023 Corales Puntacana Championship winner earns the first runner-up finish of his career (150 starts)
- 2018 John Deere Classic winner **Michael Kim** (T2/-16) records second runner-up finish of his career in 262 starts (2025 WM Phoenix Open)
- 36- and 54-hole leader **Robert MacIntyre** (T2/-16) posts the fourth runner-up finish of his career; through 13 events of the 2026 PGA TOUR Season, only four players have successfully converted the 54- hole lead/co-lead into victory
- Notable players in the field:
  - **Andrew Putnam** (-15) finishes T5 in 250<sup>th</sup> career start
  - Highest-ranked player in the field (No. 4) **Tommy Fleetwood** (T10/-11)
  - Defending champion **Brian Harman** (T39/-5)
  - 13-time PGA TOUR winner and 2021 Valero Texas Open champion **Jordan Spieth** (T63/E)

**Aon Swing 5 and Aon Next 10**

- **Aon Swing 5:** The Valero Texas Open is the final of a four-tournament stretch for players to earn FedExCup points towards the Aon Swing 5 with entry into the next Signature Event at the RBC Heritage
- The top five players, not otherwise exempt, who earned the most FedExCup points during the Puerto Rico Open, Valspar Championship, Texas Children’s Houston Open and Valero Texas Open have qualified for the RBC Heritage
