Brian Harman earned his fourth PGA TOUR career win in his 377th start. This win comes 623 days after his last (2023 The Open Championship). Harman moved from 83rd to 19th in the FedExCup Standings.

- 14** Brian Harman had his 14th round with nine or more scrambling saves in the third round of the Valero Texas Open en route to victory, tied for the third most on the PGA TOUR since 2012
- 3rd** winner on TOUR in 2025 to win after holding a 36-hole lead/co-lead (11 total)
- 2** Ranked Second in SG: Approach-the-Green and Sixth in SG: Putting en route to victory, the second time he has ranked inside the top-six in these two categories in a TOUR event (2024 PLAYERS)
- 8/8** Brian Harman hit the green on both the 17th and 18th Hole in all four rounds, he was one of four players to not miss the green on these holes in the field that week.

41% of his strokes gained for the week came on the greens at TPC San Antonio (Oaks). Harman outperformed the field by +5.3 strokes on the greens en route to victory, the first time picking up five strokes on a field putting since the 2024 U.S. Open and second consecutive year at the Valero Texas Open.

When hitting the green in regulation, Harman converted 45.45% into a birdie or better this week, the third highest of any winner at the Valero Texas Open Since 2012 and Harman's highest conversion percentage en route to victory in his PGA TOUR career.

(As part of the Returning Member Program, should Brooks Koepka finish in the top 10 of the Aon Next 10 standings, the No. 11 player will also gain access to the next Signature Event).

The top five FedExCup points earners in the Puerto Rico Open, Valspar Championship, Texas Children's Houston Open and Valero Texas Open will earn spots in the RBC Heritage via the Aon Swing 5. (As part of the Returning Member Program, should Brooks Koepka finish in the top five of the Aon Swing 5 standings, the No. 6 player will also gain access into the next Signature Event).
