Extended Forecast – Two distinct periods of showers/T-storms will be possible over the next 36 hours. The first threat could bring spotty activity to the area tonight. After a potential lull Saturday morning, a higher threat for showers/T-storms likely develops Saturday afternoon along a cold front. Cooler conditions settle in behind the front for Sunday with the potential for showers remaining in the forecast. Confidence in shower coverage and rainfall amount remains low. Otherwise, clouds likely hold in place much of Sunday with northeast winds gusting to 25 mph.
