Today – A weak front will reach TPC San Antonio and eventually dissipate over the area today. Before it dissipates, a brief window for showers will exist, mainly between 7-10am. A few strikes of lightning could also occur. Beyond this morning, the rest of the day favors dry conditions although the forecast will mention very low chances though the afternoon hours. Southerly winds will be in place much of the day with gusts over 20 mph possible this afternoon. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.15". **Sunrise: 7:22am / Sunset: 7:52pm**

Extended Forecast – Waves of drizzle or even a few showers will become possible late tonight into Friday morning. Strengthening southerly winds can be expected by Friday afternoon with gusts around 30 mph. The next front arrives on Saturday with showers/T-storms possible as it moves through the San Antonio area. Uncertainty creeps back into the forecast for the Saturday night through Sunday period as this front could linger near the area. If this materializes, another period of showers would be possible. Winds will shift to the north/northeast behind the front with gusts of 25-30 mph possible late Saturday into Sunday.
