Exemptions to Signature Events

- 2026 Genesis Invitational
- 2026 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard
- 2026 RBC Heritage
- 2026 Cadillac Championship
- 2026 Truist Championship
- 2026 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday

While the winner does not receive direct exemptions to the following events, he will improve his chances of qualifying for the following events:

• 2026 U.S. Open	Top 60 Official World Golf Ranking (date TBD)
• 2026 Open Championship	Top 50 Official World Golf Ranking (May 25, 2026)
• 2026 FedEx St. Jude Championship	Top 70 FedExCup Points List through Wyndham Championship
• 2026 BMW Championship	Top 50 FedExCup Points List through FedEx St. Jude Championship
• 2026 TOUR Championship	Top 30 FedExCup Points List through BMW Championship

MEDICAL EXTENSIONS

Players in the field on medical extensions

Players on a Major or Minor Medical Extension who meet their top 100 points will move to a category called Top 100 (Medical), listed just below exempt players on the Priority Ranking (note: if injured in a season prior to 2025, players can move to the Top 100 Medical category by reaching their top 125 number, as that was the threshold for eligibility in the season in which they were injured).

AON SWING 5

This is the final event that awards points towards the Aon Swing 5 for the first two Signature Events of the season (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational). The top five players, not otherwise exempt, who earn the most FedExCup points during the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express, Farmers Insurance Open and the WM Phoenix Open will qualify for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational. *Note: As part of the Returning Member Program, should Brooks Koepka finish in the top five of the Aon Swing 5 standings, the No. 6 player will also gain access into the next Signature Event.*

Following The Genesis Invitational, the Aon Swing 5 standings will carry over to the Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches, and the top five players in the standings (not otherwise exempt) through the Cognizant Classic will qualify for the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard.
