Viktor Hovland has one top 10 finish in his last five PGA TOUR season debuts, he has never made his season debut at this event or recorded a top 10 finish (Best: T42, 2023)

Collin Morikawa has 9 Top 5 Finishes Without a Win on the PGA TOUR since 2024, has never had a top 5 finish the WM Phoenix Open (Best: T25, 2020)

Hideki Matsuyama with a win would become the fifth player to win this event 3 times All-Time. Matsuyama (2016 & 17) and Vijay Singh (1995 & 2003) are the only international players with multiple wins at this event; Matsuyama is the only international player to win this event in back to back years since 1987

Cameron Young is looking to become the first player to win the WM Phoenix Open in their 100th career start.

Xander Schauffele his best finish after a missed cut is his win at the 2022 Zurich Classic of New Orleans, he has never missed a cut at this event in six career starts

Brooks Koepka with a win would become the fifth player to win this event 3 times All-Time. He is a 2x winner (2015 & 21) at the WM Phoenix Open, and the only player in the field this week who won this event in their debut (2015)

Min Woo Lee ranked 14th in Sand Save Percentage in 2025, his best rank to finish a season in his career and the seventh largest Sand Save improvement rank on the PGA TOUR from 2024 to 2025

Si Woo Kim has 3 consecutive top 15 finishes on the PGA TOUR This Season, he has never done this to start a season & has one top 15 finish at this event (T12, 2024)

Rickie Fowler has 4 Top 5 Finishes at the WM Phoenix Open the most at an event in his PGA TOUR career, he has not finished inside the Top 5 at this event since he won in 2019

Chris Gotterup has an average apex height of 86' 0, the sixteenth lowest ranked player on the PGA TOUR this season.

Jordan Spieth has 6 Top 10 Finishes Without a Win tied for the most of any player at this event since 1987, Spieth has 3 consecutive top 10 finishes since 2023

Scottie Scheffler with a win would become the fifth player to win this event 3 times All-Time. Scheffler is looking to become the first player since Dustin Johnson (2017) to win 3 consecutive starts

Ben Griffin was one of 3 players to record 3+ wins on the PGA TOUR in the 2025 season, Griffin had the most wins of any first time winner on the PGA TOUR last season

Matt Fitzpatrick made Birdie or Better on 100% on the Par 5's at TPC Scottsdale (Stadium Course) at the 2022 WM Phoenix Open, the only player to do so since 1987 (*min 4 rds played*)

Wyndham Clark is set to make his 7th consecutive start at the WM Phoenix Open this week, tied for his second most consecutive seasons with a start at an event in his PGA TOUR career (active streaks) & tied for the most starts at an event in his career (8th total start)

Sam Burns has not missed a cut at the WM Phoenix Open in his last 3 starts, recording two top 10 finishes in that span (T6, 2023 & T3, 2024)

Sahith Theegala is off to a hot start recording 2 Top 10 finishes in his first three events (Best Finish: T7, '26 Farmers Insurance Open), compared to first three events in 2025 recording zero top 10 finishes

J.J. Spaun made a 69' 3" putt at TPC Scottsdale (Stadium Course) in the 2017 Final Rd on the 5th Hole, marking his second longest made putt in his PGA TOUR career

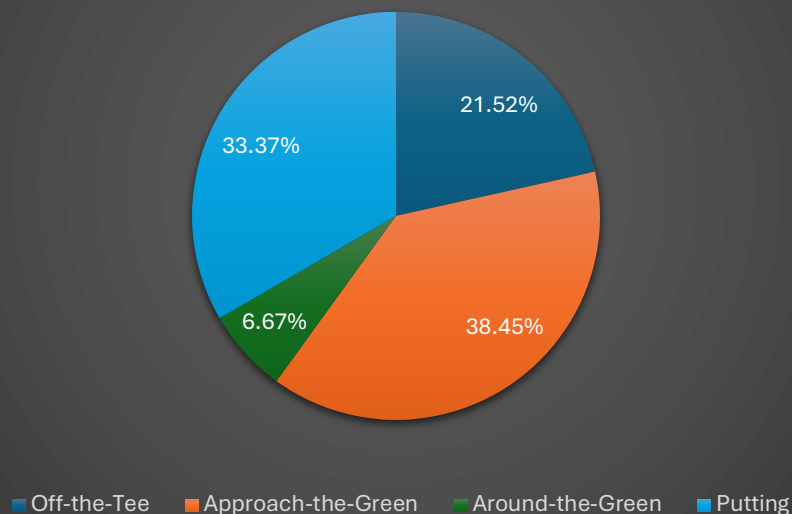

Each of the last 10 WM Phoenix Open champions ranked inside the top 10 in at least one strokes gained category. Eight of the last ten ranked inside the top 10 in Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green, accumulating for 38.45% of all strokes gained by the last 10 winners, the highest percentage of any strokes gained category. Seven of those eight players ranked inside the top five, proving hitting greens will lead to success at TPC Scottsdale Stadium Course.

Aon Next 10/Swing 5 Breakdown

The WM Phoenix Open, the fourth event of the 2026 PGA TOUR Season, is the fourth opportunity for players to earn FedExCup points towards the Aon Swing 5 with entry into each of the next two Signature Events (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, The Genesis Invitational)

The top five players, not otherwise exempt, who earn the most FedExCup points during the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express, Farmers Insurance Open and the WM Phoenix Open will qualify for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational

The Aon Next 10 represents the top 10 players not already exempt, from the FedExCup standings, while the Aon Swing 5 includes the top five FedExCup points earners, not already exempt, from a collection of Full-Field Events leading up to each Signature Event. The Aon Next 10 for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational was determined through the 2025 FedExCup Fall standings

Chris Gotterup in 2024 was the eighteenth highest ranked player on the PGA TOUR in Average Apex Height, this season he is the sixteenth lowest ranked player (160th). Gotterup's Par 4 Performance rank improved 104 positions from 2024 (T112) to 2025 (T8), the third largest improvement in that span. He also improved in Strokes Gained: Off-the-Tee (T48 – 9th), Driving Distance – All Drives (14th – 3rd), and Driving Accuracy PCT (183rd – 154th) from 2024 to 2025, one of 22 players to improve in all three statistics in that span.
