

2026 Wyndham Championship Broadcast Window Notes

Ben Griffin enters this week 36th in the FedExCup Standings, he has spent 20 of the 29 weeks this season ranked inside the top 50.

Sepp Straka has spent 126 weeks inside the FedExCup top 50 the last four seasons, tied for the most by an international player on the PGA TOUR in that span (Si Woo Kim).

Alex Smalley during his last two season on the PGA TOUR he has spent 13 weeks inside the FedExCup top 30, compared to just 6 from 2022-'24.

Ryan Gerard enters this week 16th in the FedExCup Standings, moving back inside the top 20 after the 2026 Open Championship.

Jason Day has made 18 consecutive FedExCup playoff appearances, he is on the outside looking in entering this week 75th trying to keep the longest active playoff appearance streak alive.

Jordan Spieth has not had a Top 10 finish this season, Spieth is seeking to become the second player since 2023 to qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs without a Top 10 finish (2024 Seamus Power)

Jackson Koivun is entering this week on the FedExCup cutline (70th), seeking to be tied for the second fewest starts in a season by a player to qualify for a the FedExCup (6th start this week).

Hideki Matsuyama currently ranks 24th in the FedExCup entering this week, he moved back inside the top 30 after a T3 finish at the 3M Open.

Sahith Theegala has spent 29 of the 29 weeks this season inside the FedExCup Top 50, compared to just 2 weeks in 2025, he enters the week 43rd.

Cameron Young has not been outside of the top 3 in the FedExCup Standings since after the 2026 Cadillac Championship.

Alex Fitzpatrick ranks 19th entering this week, the second best rank by a rookie on the PGA TOUR this season.

Justin Thomas enters the week 40th in the FedExCup Standings, the best rank of the four past FedExCup Champions in the field this week.

Bud Cauley enters this week 33rd in the FedExCup Standings, he has spent 13 weeks inside the top 50 this season.

Keegan Bradley is 72nd in the FedExCup Standings entering this week, he is at risk to miss the playoffs for the first time in his PGA TOUR career (15 consecutive seasons, the second longest active streak).

Brooks Koepka had his largest movement in the FedExCup standings at the cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches following his T9 finish moving from 148th to 83rd at the time.

Tom Kim has ranked inside the Top 70 in each of the last seven weeks of the season, five more than in the previous 22 weeks of the season (2).

J.T. Poston enters the week 29th in the FedExCup Standings, he has spent 7 of the 29 weeks this season ranked inside the top 30 of the FedExCup

Cameron Young earned his first PGA TOUR career win and became the 1,000th unique first-time winner on TOUR All-Time. Cameron Young led the field in SG: Putting for the first time in an event of his TOUR career.

Cameron Young gained +10.34 strokes putting in his win at the Wyndham Championship, the fifth-most by a PGA TOUR winner since 2023 and the most in his career. He gained +11.06 strokes on the front nine and lost -0.68 on the back. Young gained strokes on the greens on 49 of the 72 holes for the week. He also made 299' 5" of putts on the Front 9 and 120' 1" on the Back 9 for a combined 419' 6" of putts made.

Winners Analysis

Approach the Green

Since 2016, 41.53% of all Strokes Gained by winners at the Wyndham Championship have come from approaching the green. Seven of the last 10 winners at this event ranked inside the top four Strokes Gained: Approach the Green. In the last 10 years, five of the last 10 winners ranked inside the top three in Proximity to the Hole, with an average proximity of 27'8" compared to 32'8" by the rest of the field. Inside 100 yards winners have an average proximity to the hole of 12'3" compared to 15'6" by the rest of the field.

From 2016 to 2025 the Wyndham Championship is tied with The Sentry for the highest greens in regulation percentage of any winners in that span (83.61%). In the last 10 years winners have made birdie or better 40.37% of the time when hitting the green, compared to just 29.56% by the rest of the field. The winners also outplayed the rest of the field by hitting the green when missing the fairway 57.33% of the time compared to 53.09% by the rest of the field.
