**Omar Morales** (Puebla, Mexico) carded a bogey-free 7-under 65 and is tied for the 36-hole lead with **Danny Fisher** (Lake Forest, Illinois), who posted a 7-under 65 of his own, at the Commissionaires Ottawa Open presented by Lépine Apartments. The pair stand at 13-under and hold a one-stroke lead over first-round leader **Patrick Sheehan** (Doylestown, Pennsylvania) at the Marshes Golf Club in Ottawa, Ontario.

Morales, a second-year professional, finished No. 9 in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2025 after four seasons at UCLA. By virtue of his No. 9 finish, Morales earned Korn Ferry Tour status for the remainder of the 2025 season, totaling eight starts. This season on PGA TOUR Americas, he stands No. 29 on the Points List off the strength of four top-25 finishes and two top-10s over seven starts.

Fisher was bogey-free through the first 35 holes of the tournament before surrendering his first shot with a bogey on the par-4 ninth to conclude his second round. He totaled eight birdies on the day, with four birdies on both the front and back nine. Fisher retained PGA TOUR Americas status for the 2026 campaign with a No. 46 finish on the 2025 PGA TOUR Americas Points List.

Sheehan follows up his opening 10-under 62 with a 2-under 70. Sheehan made birdies on Nos. 7 and 18, as well as an eagle on the par-5 fifth against two bogeys on Nos. 1 and 9.

**Jonathan De Los Reyes** (Ripon, California) made an ace with a 7-iron on the 210-yard par-3 eighth en route to a bogey-free 6-under 66 and stands T44.

## About PGA TOUR Americas

PGA TOUR Americas identifies and prepares the game's future stars as players compete to earn membership on the Korn Ferry Tour and eventually the PGA TOUR. The 2026 schedule consists of 15 events in nine countries, and the season culminates in October with the Dominican Republic Tour Championship presented by Scotiabank, where the top 10 players on the season-long points list earn Korn Ferry Tour membership the following season.

Since the inaugural PGA TOUR Americas season in 2024, Johnny Keefer (2024) and Michael Brennan (2025) have finished No. 1 on the PGA TOUR Americas points list, and both players earned their PGA TOUR cards for the 2026 season.
