Patrick Flavin (Highwood, Illinois) will be seeking his second consecutive PGA TOUR Americas victory on Sunday at the Diners Club Peru Open. The 30-year-old who won the 94th Abierto del Centro Zurich presentado por Personal on April 26 in Cordoba, Argentina, fired a 7-under 65 for the second day in a row to take a two-shot lead at Los Inkas Golf Club. At 19-under 197, Flavin moved away from the pack with an eagle on 14 and a birdie on 15 late on Saturday.

“I’ve definitely been playing really nice golf, and I’m excited to see it showing up again, getting myself back in contention, which is super exciting,” said the Miami (Ohio) University alum who turned pro in 2018. “I think I’m just doing a lot of stuff really, really well. I’m just trying to keep the same mindset of just getting better each day.”

Dawson Armstrong (Spring Hill, Tennessee) carded a 7-under 65 as well to move into solo second at 17-under 199. **Walker Lee** (Houston, Texas) and **Joshua Lee** (Jacksonville, Florida) are tied for third at 16-under 200.

A Monday qualifier this week, **Jose de Jesús Rodríguez** (Irapuato, Mexico) remains the leading Latin American player. He joins **Joseph Winslow** (Overland Park, Kansas) in a tie for fifth at 15-under.

The outright leader by one shot through 36 holes, **Conner Godsey** (Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida) carded a 1-over 73 to drop into a tie for ninth at 13-under.

Defending champion **Hunter Wolcott** (Dickson, Tennessee) remains T39 at 8-under, while 2023 champion **Marcos Montenegro** (Loberia, Argentina) is T26 at 10-under.

Andre Chi (Flushing, New York) had an ace at the challenging par-3 17th early in the day. He hit a 4-iron from 226 yards onto an elevated green on his way to a round of 3-under 69. Chi is T39 at 8-under.

Final-round tee times (twosomes) will run from 7:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. Peru Time off No. 1 tee.

About PGA TOUR Americas

PGA TOUR Americas identifies and prepares the game's future stars as players compete to earn membership on the Korn Ferry Tour and eventually the PGA TOUR. The 2026 schedule consists of 15 events in nine countries, and the season culminates in October with the PGA Oceans 4 Tour Championship presented by Scotiabank, where the top 10 players on the season-long points list earn Korn Ferry Tour membership the following season.

Since the inaugural PGA TOUR Americas season in 2024, Johnny Keefer (2024) and Michael Brennan (2025) have finished No. 1 on the PGA TOUR Americas Points List, and both players earned their PGA TOUR cards for the 2026 season.
