Things to Know

- **David Toms** heads into the final round with a three-stroke lead after carding the low round of the day (63) at the Chubb Classic presented by SERVPRO.

David Toms, 67-63 – 130 (-14)

- Carded the low round of the day by three strokes and matched the low 18-hole score at Tiburón Golf Club since the Chubb Classic moved there in 2021.
 - Previous instances of 63 at Tiburón: Fred Couples (2021/R1), Alex Cejka (2023/R3), Rocco Mediate (2024/R1)
- Matched his second-lowest round on PGA TOUR Champions (549th round).
 - Low 18: 62 (2019 U.S. Senior Open, 1st Round)
 - Previous rounds of 63: 2017 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai (2nd Round), 2019 Boeing Classic (2nd Round), 2023 Sanford International (1st Round)
- This is his second 18-hole score of 64 or better this season (fifth round) after not recording a score that low in 2025 as an individual.
 - Low 18-hole score in an individual event in 2025: 66 (Boeing Classic/R3)
- This is his low 18-hole score at the Chubb Classic (28th round).
 - Previous low: 65 (2018/R3)
- The 59-year-old seeks his fifth win on PGA TOUR Champions (176th start).
 - Last win: 2023 Galleri Classic
- Making his second start of the 2026 season, he finished T20 at the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai (Jan. 22-24)
- Holds the lead/co-lead entering the final round of a 54-hole event for the sixth time on PGA TOUR Champions (2-for-5). This total does not include two tournaments that were reduced to 36 holes (2021 Insperity Invitational, 2024 Invited Celebrity Classic).
 - Won the 2023 Galleri Classic
 - Won the 2023 Cologuard Classic
- Making his 10th appearance at the Chubb Classic, he has five top-10 finishes.

- Best finish: 2018 (T2)

Michael Wright, 65-68 – 133 (-11)

- The 51-year-old Australian seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (45th start).
 - Best finish: T5 (two times; 2024 Sanford International, 2025 DICK'S Open)
- Was one of two co-leaders after the first round along with Darren Clarke.
- Making his second appearance at the Chubb Classic, he finished T12 in 2025.

Other Notes

- Defending champion **Justin Leonard** (T3) carded 68 and sits four strokes back entering the final round.
 - He looks to become the fourth player to win the Chubb Classic in back-to-back years, joining Lee Trevino (1990-91), Mike Hill (1993-94) and Bernhard Langer (2022-23).
 - With a win on Sunday, he would become the first player on PGA TOUR Champions to successfully defend a title since Stewart Cink (2025 Ally Challenge).
- **Ricardo Gonzalez** (T3) posted 68 and sits 10-under heading into Sunday. The 56-year-old Argentine seeks his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (64th start).
 - Last win: 2024 Trophy Hassan II
- Making his PGA TOUR Champions debut, Naples native **George McNeill** sits T14 at 5-under. McNeill turned 50 years old on October 2, 2025.
- 18-hole co-leader **Darren Clarke** (T26) shot 76, which included a triple bogey on No. 13 and a double bogey on No. 17.
- **John Rollins** withdrew before the start of the second round. **John Huston** withdrew after the second round.
