## Things to Know

- Despite two double bogeys in his first six holes on Sunday, 36-hole leader **David Toms** got up-and-down from a greenside bunker for birdie on No. 18 to win the Chubb Classic presented by SERVPRO by one stroke over a trio of players: **Boo Weekley**, **Michael Wright** and defending champion **Justin Leonard**.

## David Toms, 67-63-73 – 203 (-13)

- The 59-year-old earned his fifth win on PGA TOUR Champions (177 starts).
  - Wins (5): 2018 U.S. Senior Open, 2021 Stifel Charity Classic, 2023 Cologuard Classic, 2023 Galleri Classic, 2026 Chubb Classic
- Moves up to No. 2 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings (\$296,500) behind Stewart Cink (\$340,000).
  - Toms opened his 2026 season with a T20 finish at the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai (Jan. 22-24)
- Earned his first win at the Chubb Classic (10th appearance).
  - Previous best finish: T2 (2018)
- Improved to 3-for-6 when leading/co-leading entering the final round of a 54-hole event on PGA TOUR Champions. This total does not include events reduced to 36 holes.
  - Previous wins with 36-hole lead/co-lead: 2023 Cologuard Classic, 2023 Galleri Classic
- His final-round 73 is the high finish by a winner on PGA TOUR Champions since the 2023 ISPS HANNA Senior Open (Alex Cejka shot 76).
  - It is the high finish by a winner of a non-major on PGA TOUR Champions since the 2023 Trophy Hassan II (Stephen Ames shot 73).

## Other Notes

- Defending champion **Justin Leonard** (T2) birdied two of his last five holes en route to a final-round 70. This is his fourth top-5 finish in his last six starts on PGA TOUR Champions, dating back to last season.
- **Boo Weekley** (T2) matched the low round of the day with bogey-free 67 to earn his best finish on PGA TOUR Champions (57 starts).
  - Previous best finish: T3 (2025 DICK'S Open)
- **Michael Wright** (T2) closed with 71 and earned his best finish on PGA TOUR Champions (45 starts).
  - Previous best finish: T5 (two times; 2024 Sanford International, 2025 DICK'S Open)
- Making his PGA TOUR Champions debut, Naples native **George McNeill** finished T5 at 9-under after closing with 68. McNeill turned 50 years old on October 2, 2025.
- World Golf Hall of Fame member **Davis Love III** withdrew during the final round.
